CLEVELAND (AP)—Blank declaration of candidacy to be filled in by candidates for delegates and alternates to the democratic national convention were received Wednesday at headquarters of the Cuyahoga county chairman from the office of State Chairman W. W. Durbin of Columbus, hearing the written consent of former Governor James M. Cox to the use of his name as a candidate for president and that of former Governor James E. Campbell as a second choice for the presidential nomination. The blank declarations were received by Tom R. Brannon, treasurer of Cuyahoga county democratic committee, who authorized the announcement.

BRITISH DEFENDED BY SENATOR FESS

COLUMBUS, O. (INS).—"Great Britain has suffered extreme humiliation because of the breakdown caused by the war. If her economic situation is not remedied she must change her whole industrial career or decline," asserted United States Senator Simon D. Fess, Ohio, in an address here. "Great Britain faces the most stupendous problem of the ages, and you and I ought to be concerned."

"It is not a matter of sentiment," continued Senator Fess. "The conditions prevailing were left by the war. So much of the capital of the old world has been driven to our country that we have more than we need. But it cannot go back. There is no economic stability over there. "If the separation of Britain and France were caused by religion race or even chiefly by politics the difference could be composed in conference. But the difference is economic, and the economic law is as certain as the gravitation law. It cannot be changed by entering into agreements."

Senator Fess declared it is un-likely to charge Great Britain a "dollar charge," or France is purely militaristic and is doing what Germany did before the world war. He said British statesmen are concerned with the perpetuity of the life of their country.
