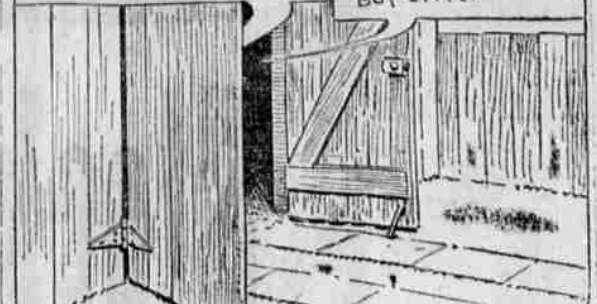
"Hunchback" Said to Be True to Life—Now at Arcade.

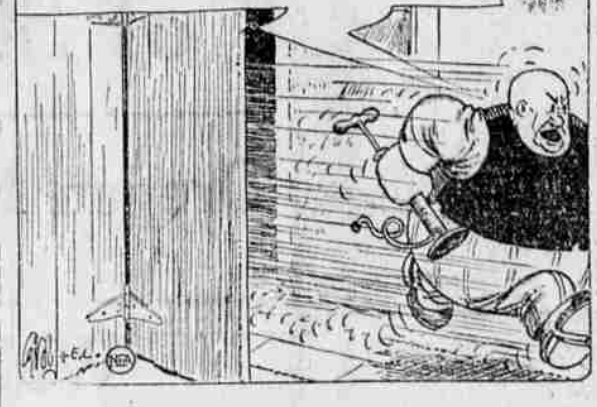

Turkish Women Demand More Modern Laws and Abolition of Polygamy

CONSTANTINOPLE, (INS).—Turkish women are agitating for the same rights possessed by women of other countries.

At a largely attended meeting of women of the educated class held in this city to discuss women's rights in family life, a general desire to end the practice of polygamy was expressed.

The meeting passed resolutions

demanding that laws regulating marriages, divorces and polygamy on modern lines should be framed, and a committee was formed to draft the reform.

"Polygamy, which is authorized by our present laws, is a relic of past ages," said one speaker. "We must break with this tradition, which in any event, has not been practiced for the last twenty years."

The authorities are said to be sympathetic toward the women's demand.
