ASTORIA, OR.—The pumping of sand from the river to fill the streets in the devastated section of the city was completed by the Tillamook Construction company. There were a few small spaces at the higher elevations which remained to be filled with rocks, but with the single exception of the stretch about 150 feet in length on Commercial street, near Seventeenth, where the retaining wall broke, the entire sand fill will be finished this week.

Telephone and telegraph companies are laying their conduits, the pouring of the concrete for the sidewalk posts is under way and within three weeks the laying of the concrete paving in the streets will be started.
