LONDON (AP)—Schoolmasters "shy and retiring souls that they are," ought to buck up and be aggressive, and take hold of the world, for they are the most important people in the whole civilized community, says H. G. Wells.

When Mr. Wells delivered himself of these opinions, in an address to the annual meeting of the Incorporated Association of American Teachers, at the Secondary School, some of the assembly teachers applauded and others laughed.

Mr. Wells did not laugh. "I want to teach shamelessness to school teachers," he said. "I want to teach their arrogance and aggression. Arrogance and aggression is the worst of the world and is a characteristic of all school teachers. A lot of them seem to be unconscious of the amount and danger of their functions. They don't seem to realize that the world is not a going concern. But a finished affair in which they have a very substantial and important part. They are a shy and specialized part. They keep together even on their holidays. Then Mr. Wells turned his thoughts to this 'new and better world,' this 'reconstructed human'

life" that "high-minded people" talk so much about these days. He said that when the reconstructed human life exists, school teachers will be the very soul and center of it. Only by and through teachers, heroic teachers, he said, would it be possible to conceive of any escape from "the distressful and unsatisfactory life that mankind lives today."

"fruitless paternalism," to that of Senator Gooding, Republican, Idaho, who held that it should be laid aside in favor of the McNary-Haughen bill, proposing a one hundred million dollar corporation to export surplus farm products. The latter measure would aid all agriculture, Senator Gooding insisted, and would accomplish the same purpose designed to be effected "locally" by the bill before the senate.

The Idaho senator announced that he had withdrawn a bill prepared by himself because he believed the export corporation idea was far better. There were indications, however, that the McNary bill, sponsored by Senator McNary, Republican, Oregon, also would meet with determined opposition, both in the house and senate. Representative Anderson, Republican, Minnesota, chairman of the congressional committee for agricultural inquiry, announced he would oppose it as "unworkable and impracticable."

Debate Is General. The senate debate was participated in by more than 20 members and was enlivened by Senator Norris, Republican, Nebraska, when he adopted the method of the school room to press home his points in favor of the Norbeck measure. Assisted by charts showing graphically the trend of farm products in the northwest, the Nebraska senator traced these plotted lines with a long ferrule as he insisted the government "own a special recompense to these men."
