Circular Saw Cuts Wrist of John Burlach; Latest Reports Are That He Is Doing Nicely.

CLOVER CREEK, (Special).—While mowing wood with a circular saw on the farm of Ben Blaise March 2, John Burlach, brother of Mrs. Blaise, reached across the saw to attach a small spring that had become loosened. His arm came in contact with the saw cutting a deep gash between three and four inches across the thick part of the arm between the wrist and the elbow. First aid was administered by Mr. and Mrs. Blaise and he was rushed to the hospital at Baker. It was found all the muscles were cut loose and that it had just missed an artery. It was necessary to administer an anesthetic and he will be compelled to remain at the hospital at least ten days, but his arm will be saved.

The escape way of the mine all of Monday and Monday night and with hundreds of electric lights strung out throughout the entrance continued their gruesome task of removing the dead.

Bodies were brought out on stretchers to the entrance and there identification was made, if possible, and the remains loaded aboard automobiles, undertakers' automobiles, a United States mail truck and other conveyances.

Legion Active.
It is estimated there were ten former service men in the mine at the time the disaster occurred and American Legion men have taken over the task of poling the immediate vicinity of Knights of Pythias castle which, with the V. M. C. A. building, has been turned into a morgue.

The legion men have roped off a certain area, placed guards and busied themselves about town notifying relatives of men whose bodies were brought in.

one street of this little coal mining town was crowded with automobiles carrying rescue workers to the mine from neighboring coal camps and with relatives and friends of entombed men.

There were many pathetic scenes. Young mothers carrying small babies were frequent visitors at the morgue or fuel company of officers seeking word of loved ones. Despite the great disaster that has overtaken Castle Gate the people here—and it is estimated that not a single family but what is some way affected—have conducted themselves exceptionally well. There has not been the wild confusion which in most cases prevails.

Monday, a crew of 75 men labored in the little Castle Gate cemetery, located in the canyon

and at the very portals of the mine, digging individual graves. It is believed that many of the bodies already recovered will be buried here and some of them will be shipped to other parts of the state for burial.

The little schoolhouse here at Castle Gate has been converted into a bankhouse for mine rescue crews and the several teachers, their pupils excited until further notice, are taking part in the relief work.
