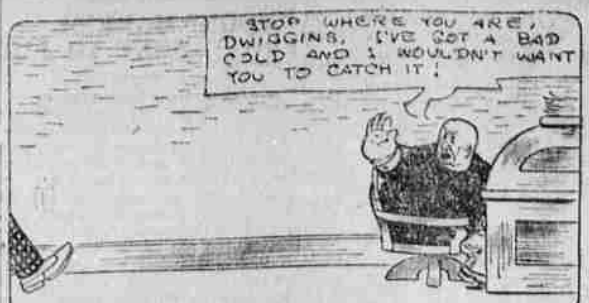

## S. O. S. OVERWORKED, SO WOULD ADOPT NEW CALL

FOR LESS SHIP PERIL LONDON (INS).—Shipping circles are discussing the advisability of introducing a new distress call for use when a ship is in need of assistance, but not in any immediate danger.

This is stated to be necessary owing to the increasing number of ships that send out S. O. S. calls on the slightest provocation. Captain Brown, commander of the liner Ansonia, reported that during a bad storm on his last eastward trip S. O. S. calls were almost incessant, and he was of the opinion that this call had lost its significance owing to its excessive use.

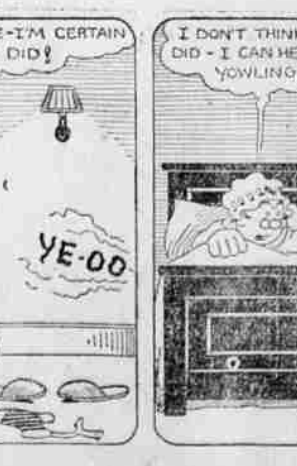

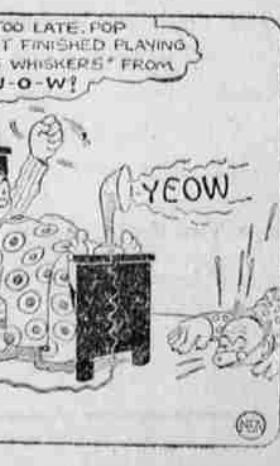
