Clinton W. Gilbert, who wrote "The Mirrors of Washington" has been peeping in all the looking glasses about the capital recently to see if he could catch a glimpse of an ideal candidate for president in 1924.

Apparently the candidates in the field are an uncouth bunch, who don't use mirrors in making up for the public, or else they are afraid to face themselves and Gilbert in the glass, for he came up with the result of his quest thus tersely:

"I could count up the ideal candidates for president this year on the fingers of a man who had both arms shot away in the late war."

Senator Robert L. Owen of Oklahoma might justly claim a purer Americanism than any other member of the senate. He is the one senator boasting a strain of Indian blood, being descended through his mother, from the Cherokee tribe.

Despite his 65 years, Owen is one of the younger members of the senate in appearance. Straight as an arrow with the stolidly handsome face of an Indian brave, Owen is one of the striking figures in congress.

Although he has served Oklahoma in the senate ever since she gained statehood, Owen announces he will not fight for re-election this year. 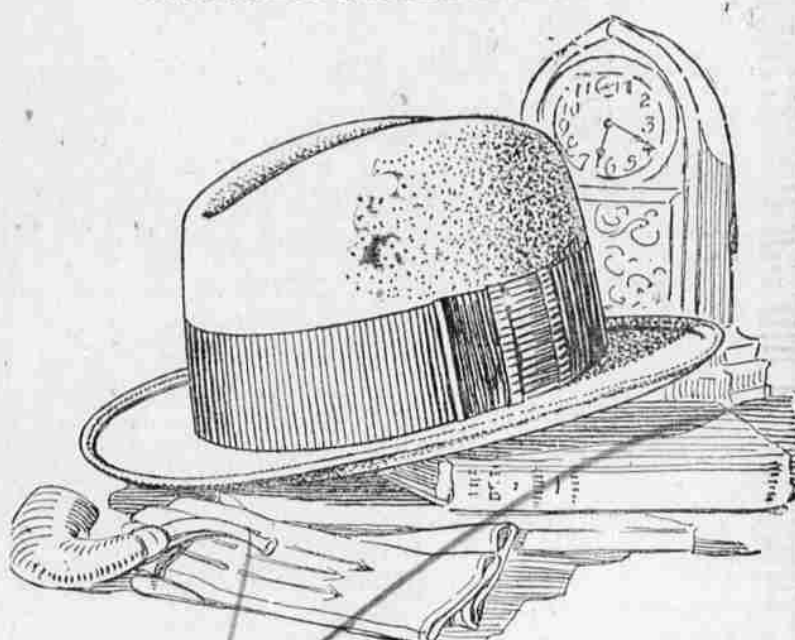
