Germany Lacks Sailors.

HAMBURG (AP)—Sixty thousand German sailors and officers had to find other jobs when the German fleet was dismantled under the Versailles Treaty. The merchant navy today has recovered half of its pre-war tonnage, and here are not enough sailors to man the ships. This is because he old-time marine men have mostly gone into other work and a majority of them were capable, have obtained positions which they do not care to surrender. Some have gone to other countries.

Consequently Germany is now forced to begin the training of large numbers of sailors, and new schools for sailors are being organized.
