## AVIERS CHASE IS ALIVE AND HIDING IN ITALY

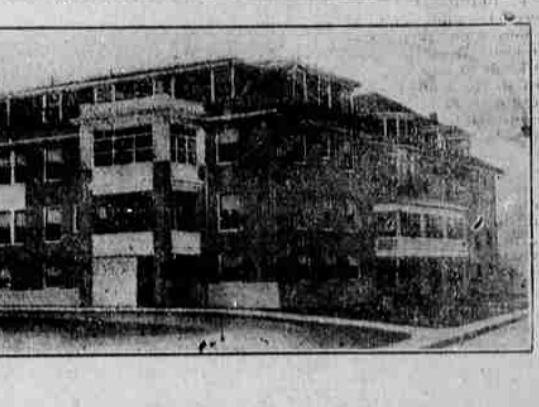
