form as secretary of navy to succeed Edwin Denby is inevitably viewed in Washington from the possible political as well as general significance.

The extent to which Wilbur's selection may strengthen Coolidge's position in California, as against Hiram Johnson, in the coming campaign, is naturally a subject for speculation.

Wilbur's appointment gives California two representatives in the cabinet—more than any other state. With the friends of a secretary of navy and a secretary of commerce—for Hoover is also a Californian—quitting for Calvin in his home state, Johnson's fight may be made much more difficult.

However, Hiram is conceded to be still a considerable problem so far as California goes.

Wilbur's entry into the cabinet puts a number of things in pairs. He makes the second member of the cabinet who is a graduate of Annapolis Naval Academy, the other being Secretary of War Weeks. Weeks graduated in '81, Wilbur in '88. He is also the second member claiming Iowa as his birth state, the other Iowa being Hoover, who is now his fellow Californian.

Maybe Hoover and Wilbur are expected to help out in Iowa as well as in California. For Iowa—due to the influence of Senator Brookhart and his (World Forum)

labor and Non-partisan League friends—is also a cause of some perturbation in the conservative Coolidge camp.

Pendleton to Hold Festival.

PENDLETON, Ore.—A decision to present a festival in Pendleton again this spring has been reached and the Pendleton Commercial association has agreed to see that the show is underwritten. Roy Raley, local attorney, the father of the Happy Canyon show and for many years a leader in the presentation of the Pendleton Round-Up, will direct the festival.
