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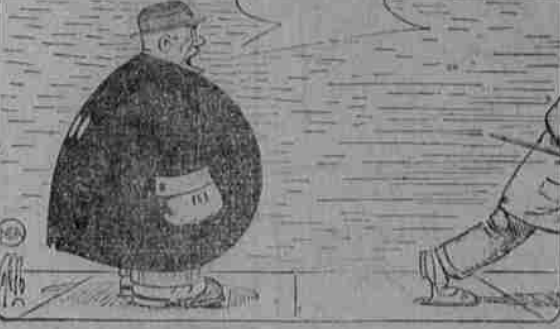

NEW FOOTBALL RULES WRONG

Veteran Grid Coach, Now at Stanford, Believes Changes Hurt Game.

(BY JACK LAMONT—THURSDAY) MAX FRANCISCO (INS) speaks in changes just adopted by the football rules commission have out the coast gridiron coaches up in the air.

Coach Smith thinks the center kickoff will greatly reduce the football as far as the spectators are concerned.

The California mentor told the writer:

"The old kickoff as played in the last few years has been a great thrill from a spectator standpoint, but as the rule now stands I have an idea that the ball will often be kicked over the goal line, which will mean there will be no action in the eyes of the spectators and will result in a poor, rattling kickoff."

Coach Warner comments on the new rule as follows:

"I think there was need of it."
