DORIS SHANNON WINS CONTEST

Miss Doris Shannon of the Sophomore class of the La Grande high school won the essay contest recently conducted by the Eastern Oregon Light and Power company on the "Advantages of Electric Lighting" and was awarded an electrical prize.

Following is the essay: "The Advantages of An Electric Range."

Electricity is becoming an important factor in the home and shop. In a few more years practically all of the work will be done by electricity. The electric range is not new but has not been used as much as other electric articles.

A few housewives have realized how essential an electric range is in the home.

Every housewife should own an electric range. It not only saves time and energy but it also saves expenses.

When getting a meal on an electric range, it is so arranged that some one does not have to be in the kitchen all the time when getting the meal, although it is being cooked just as thoroughly as if it were in the kitchen every minute.

The Average housewife spends the most time in the warm summer months of the year. Cooking becomes more or less of a burden to her, but with an electric range very little heat escapes into the room to make it warm. The electric range is more easily cleaned and kept clean than a coal or wood range.

How inconvenient to have to build a big fire to cook a small quantity of food and how much extra food you waste? But with the electric range you can have the same amount of heat in much smaller quantities and you need not waste any heat at all.

Every housewife knows how much extra work wood and coal make with the other ranges. Your ceilings become smoked and look dingy. The housewife becomes disgusted and discouraged. All of this work and inconvenience can be avoided by having an electric range in the home. There is no smoke to smoke the walls and ceilings and no wood and coal to make extra dirt. Therefore the housewife is able to devote more time to other things besides her housework.

The new electric range is suitable for the large oven space. A person can cook an oven dinner in it at one time and have plenty of room. The oven is thoroughly packed so as not to let the heat escape into the room. The range has a large warmer that keeps the food piping hot until you wish to serve it. The range also has a model oven door which can be used as a serving table with safety.

The newest features of electric ranges are more than satisfactory and they will be in almost every home before long.

Parking Space Comes High. When Boston Plays Good Ball. BOSTON, (AP)—On Commonwealth Avenue, Boston, lies a block of land thought to be unique in that its rental rises and falls yearly with the rise or fall in the league standing of a baseball club. The land is "Lowell Park," used as a parking space opposite the Braves' field. The rental is determined each year by the position in which the Braves finished at the end of the previous year's National League pennant race.

If the Braves are fortunate enough to win the pennant, the house will have an annual rental of \$5,000 to pay, the succeeding season. If they finish second, \$500 is cut from that price. If they end the season in third place, the rent will be \$2,500 and fourth place is \$1,000 less. If the Braves conclude the season in fifth place or lower, the rent will be \$1,000.

Building Companies Prosper. CLEVELAND, (AP)—Building savings and loan companies during the last year made the largest growth in their history, according to Miss Ann E. Line of Niagara Falls, president, who was here making arrangements for the organization's convention July 22-25.

There are now more than 10,000 loan companies in the United States, which serve more than seven million persons, Miss Line said. One in four associations have just stepped into first place among the states with assets exceeding \$500,000,000 and serving 1,700,000 persons.

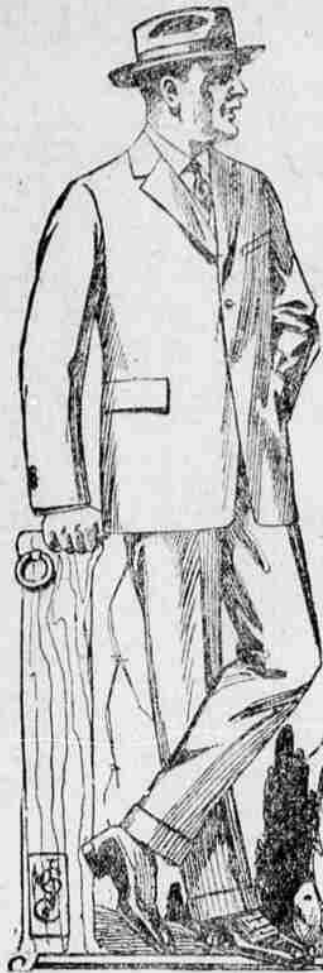
