IMBLER WINS CHAMPIONSHIP

High School Baseball Nine Victor in Eleventh Consecutive Game This Year.

IMBLER (Special).—On Friday afternoon the Imbler high school won its ninth consecutive baseball game of the season when it defeated North Powder, at North Powder, by a score of 12 to 0. Not only did Imbler shut out the home team, but only one hit was made off pitcher Ledbetter, a 12-5 league in the seventh that sent Imbler Wilson could not catch each. Two men reached first on errors.

Imbler now has all but clinched an overwhelming eight to the championship of Eastern Oregon. In the nine games Imbler has made 153 scores to 27 for opponents. Every game has been decided by Imbler before the seventh inning. Imbler's batting average is .368. Third baseman Kronen has made 28 hits in 49 times at bat, 14 of the 28 hits being for extra bases. His average is .511. Spies, Wilson and Ledbetter all have averages above .400.

Counting last year's record, Imbler makes 15 straight games won without a loss. Imbler high school is anxious to play La Grande, Union or any other high school team in this part of Oregon.
