LUMBER TRADE STILL QUIET

Quietness continues to prevail in the lumber market, says the American Lumberman, Chicago. The south remains the busiest region, building there assuming good volume. Construction operations in the middle west, north and east show fair development, and a better feeling is noted in some of the agricultural sections. Retail lumber dealers are moving out much lumber from their yards but are pursuing a conservative policy and are limiting their buying to strict necessities. They are running their stocks down to low levels, and most of their orders are small and for badly mixed cuts for sorting on purposes. General industrial activity in building production recently having slackened in many important wood-consuming trades and buying being done with utmost caution. Competition for orders is keen among lumber manufacturers, as well as between species, with the result that prices have eased off to where the present market is decidedly in favor of the buyer.

Prospects, however, are not discouraging. The feeling is that a gradual betterment in conditions in and out of the lumber trade will follow the adjournment of congress and the presidential nominations. The general disposition meanwhile is to sit tight and await developments.

Northern pine for the Douglas fir market has shown any reportable change since last week. Demand, though spotty, totals a fair volume, but offerings are plentiful, resulting in strong competition. Southern hardwoods have a fair sale from flooring and other building material interests, but find a generally listless market. As new stocks have been coming into the market, there have been no price advances.

Northern hardwoods, while affected by the quietness in the demand from the automobile, bus and other large consuming industries, remain comparatively strong due to the continued shortage of

dry stocks in Wisconsin and Michigan.

Four Formosan Girls Seek Death in Suicide Pact

TAIPEI, Formosa. (AP)—A suicide pact among four young girls of one of the aboriginal Formosan tribes in the interior of this island, resulting in the death of two of the covenanters, brought to light an invasion of modern ideas even into that fastness of savage life.

The four girls, between 15 and 18 years old, all had had modern education in schools established by the Japanese. They had heard something about the right of women to decide for themselves in regard to marriage, an entirely new idea in the community in which they were reared. When the parents of one tried to force her into an unwelcome marriage, the four agreed to die together. They tried hanging. Two succeeded, but the trees selected by the others broke under their weight and they lived.

WOULD MAKE DUBLIN A "SECOND MONTE CARLO"

DUBLIN, (IRISH)—A million-and-a-quarter-dollar scheme to make Dublin a second Monte Carlo and the Mecca of the English and American gamblers is revealed in a government report here.

The plan, according to the committee which investigated its merits, was to establish, in the vicinity of Dublin, a modern, well-equipped hotel or casino, furnished with the most sporting facilities such as are available at Monte Carlo and other famous resorts, as a counterattraction to these places.

The company making the offer stated it would furnish the hotel with necessary amenities for gambling and sports of all kinds and that the government should take 25 percent of the profits and the company the rest, on a twenty-year lease.

Week-end gambling parties from England are predicted if the scheme comes to fruition.
