San Francisco Golfer Leads in Chicago Play

CHICAGO (By the Associated Press)—McDonald Smith, of San Francisco, shooting the last nine in one under par Wednesday, finished in the lead of 42 golfers from the west who qualified at Oak Park Country club for the national open golf championship at Detroit by totaling 148 strokes for the 24 holes. The California open champion scored par 72 Tuesday but required 41 strokes for the first nine Wednesday and took 76 for the round. This allowed him to finish one stroke ahead of Emmett French, Youngstown, Ohio, who shared the best score for the day's round with 73 with Dave Robertson of Detroit. Harry Hampton, Canton, Ohio, and George Kerrigan of Los Angeles tied for third place at 150, while Al Watrous of Grand Rapids came next with 151.
