RULES AND REGULATIONS UNION COUNTY BANKERS ASSOCIATION

In view of the conditions brought about with in the past few years on account of the increased cost of paper, printing of checks, check covers, pass books, and other materials used in connection with the operation of checking accounts and the cost to the banks in handling a checking account carrying an average balance of less than \$50.00, being considerably in excess of any profit that can be derived from this account, it has become necessary that the banks throughout the country adopt a more conservative and business like method in order to avoid loss in serving small depositors. The following rules have been mutually adopted by the banks of Union County to take effect June 1st 1924.

Similar regulations have been in effect in all the larger banks of the country for years, and are now being put into effect by most of the county organizations in this state. This is being done at the urgent suggestion of representatives of the Treasury Department as well as the Oregon State Bankers Association. The charges made effective at this time are for the sole purpose of defraying the actual expense of rendering the service to the public which they have a right to expect.

1. A Minimum Charge of 50 cents will be made on all loans.
2. The cost of extra printing on all checks for business or personal use will be defrayed by the customer.
3. The initial charge of all contracts and agreements handled in excess will be \$1.00.
4. Loans of less than \$500.00 will be discounted and interest collected quarterly on larger amounts.
5. A service charge of 50 cents per month will be made on all checking accounts of which the average monthly balance is less than \$50.00. THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.

In adopting these rules it is not the desire of the banks to discourage the handling of checking accounts or to leave the impression that we do not desire the account of the man, woman or child of small or limited means, but on the contrary we desire to co-operate with you and assist you to main-

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
