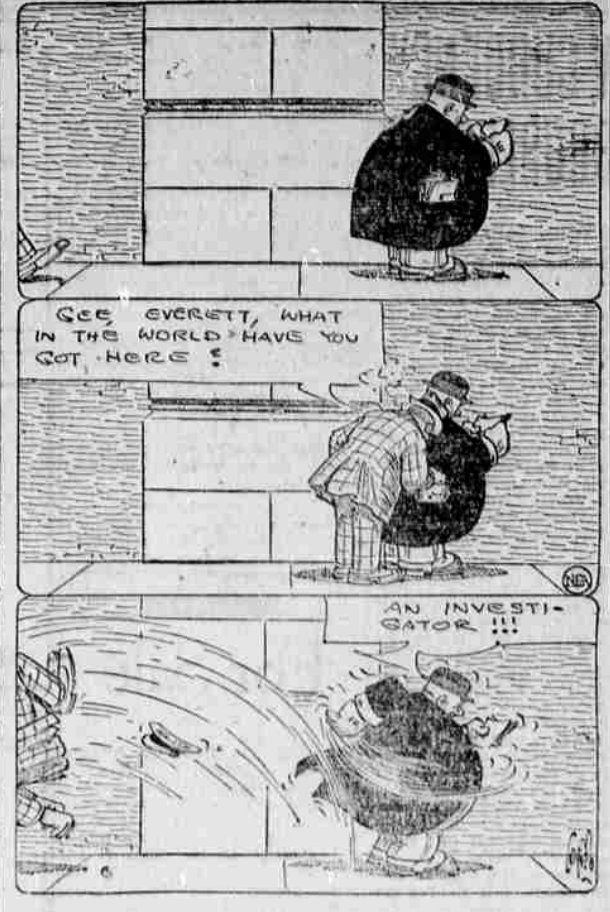

**HUSSEIN IS STILL ON JOB**  
 King of Hedjaz is Pressing His Claim as Moslem Caliph.

JERUSALEM, (AP)—King Hussein of the Hedjaz has at last left Amman, the Transjordan capital, for his own seat at Mecca the Forbidden in time to celebrate the Moslem Ramadan.

His visit left a trail of rumors. Hussein remained during his comparatively short stay in and about Amman to have himself proclaimed caliph. He has returned to his capital as the Quarantine and Hashimite King, Prince of the Faithful, at least so far as a section of the Moslem Arabs of Palestine and Transjordan are concerned.

His title to the caliphate is disputed by some of the Moslems of Egypt, who are putting forward King Faisal as their own candidate. The Moslems of India have not been heard from on the subject, although it is said that while part of them, at least, have tacitly consented to Hussein, others prefer to await the outcome of the proposed all-Moslem assembly. Reports from Syria are that the French authorities there have forbidden prayers in behalf of the self-proclaimed caliph.

There is much speculation in Palestine as to what will be the attitude of the British government towards Hussein as the applicant to

administration. Transjordan has nominally at least always formed part of the Palestine administration, and there was considerable feeling when it was officially separated in the Palestine mandate.

With regard to the caliphate and Hussein's aspirations thereto, the Jews found themselves in the unique position of having to take a stand on a matter that concerns them not at all. Responsible Zionist representatives here realized the desirability of an early reappraisal of the claim and have secured from him favorable expressions of opinion as to his intentions towards the Jews, whose commingling to the Arab race he has repeatedly acknowledged.
