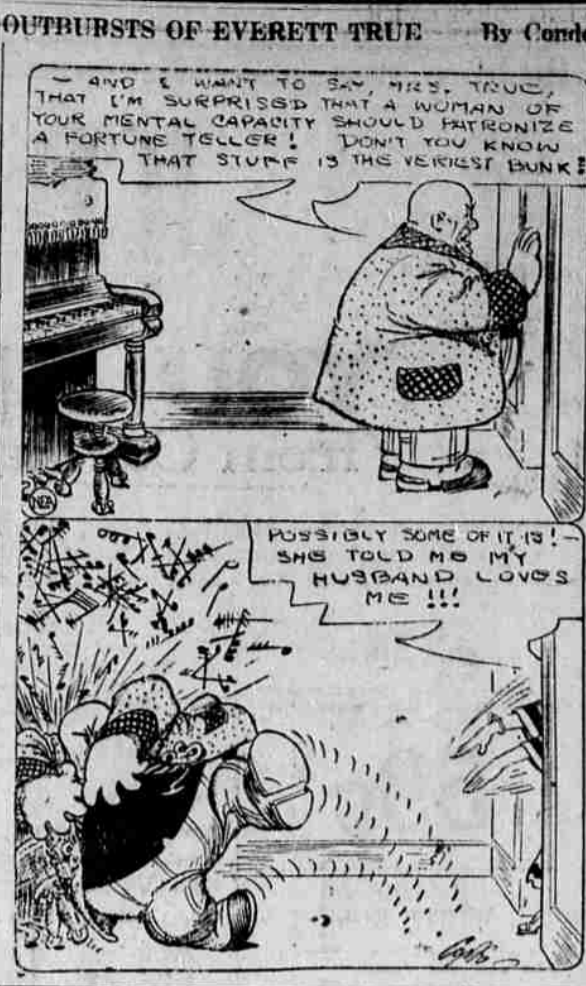
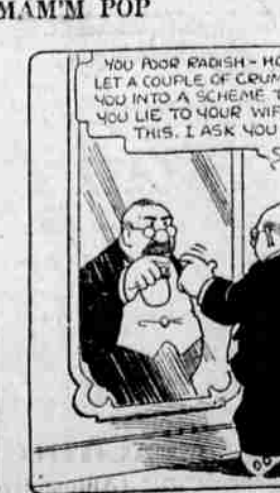

the republic, numbering about 250,000, had appointed one delegate from each hundred schools to represent them at the session, which was held under the auspices of the government. In the presence of President of the Republic, Dr. Masaryk, Dr. Benes and all the other ministers, the children discussed questions of a moral or humanitarian order. They also made an inspection into the domain of current politics, for they appealed to their seniors present in the public galleries to do everything to preserve peace.

The general impression was that the success of the function and the excellence of the speeches made, bore a happy testimony to the good work done by Mrs. Masaryk in the popular education campaign about Russia since the Russian Revolution.

MOSEOW (AP)—Two airplanes constructed in Russian factories for the Persian government have safely arrived at Teheran, says the Rosta agency. The machines started from Enzeli, which is 250 miles from Teheran, and took only one hour and forty-five minutes to make the journey. The premier, members of the cabinet and the soviet diplomatic representatives were present at the aerodrome when the machines landed.
