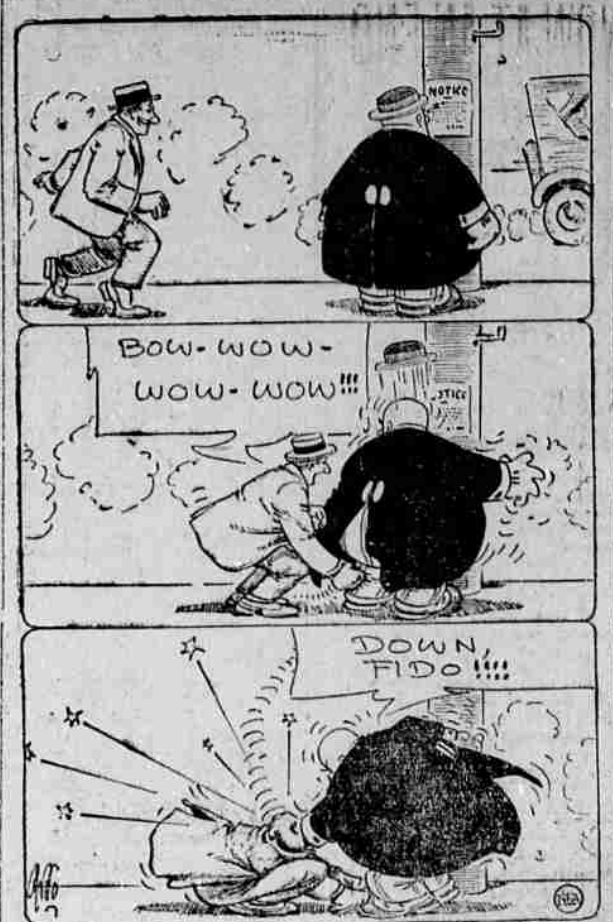

Last Showing of
"The Rendezvous"
At Sherry's Tonight.

Marshall Nichols' new picture for Goldwyn, "The Rendezvous," from the original story by Jacques line Ruthven, was screened last night at the Sherry theater, and proved to be one of the best productions made by this master of film technique.

The film is an exceedingly dramatic one. Its characters are picturesque and the settings exotic. Prince Sergei Tamiroff has been called to Siberia for marrying against the czar's wishes. DISEASE GERM IS DISCOVERED

BERLIN. (AP)—Bacteriologists throughout Europe have been interested in the recent announcement here of the discovery of a bacillus capable of reproducing the hoof and mouth disease in animals. Specialists have come to Berlin to investigate further, while there have been many letters and cables from the United States and England, where there have been epidemics this spring. News of the discovery came from Professor Paul Frosch, of the Royal Veterinary college, who has been working on the problem several years in conjunction with Professor Dohner.

The new bacillus has not yet been subjected to sufficient confirmatory tests to make it possible to say positively that it is the final solution of the difficulty, but several journals in Germany and England have written enthusiastic articles about it, and various authorities have ventured to predict that this enthusiasm has not been misplaced.

According to writers on veterinary subjects in these periodicals the hoof and mouth disease is supposed to have been a European epidemic for more than 2,000 years though it was not until the seventh and eighteenth centuries that positive proof of its presence was found.

Stirling Career in Montana

SASKATOON, Sask. (AP)—After a stirring career of 37 years in the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, assistant commissioner Theodore A. Wroughton has retired from the force.

Colonel Wroughton joined the force as a constable in 1887. He was promoted to be inspector in 1898 and elevated to the post of assistant commissioner in 1919.

To Colonel Wroughton fell the duty of pursuing criminal single-handed over trackless wilds. Later he will prosecute and magistrate some 25,000 men during the Yukon gold rush. Finally he exercised the police power over millions of square miles in the Arctic.

In the first two years, Colonel Wroughton was in command of the Yukon territory he sentenced 2,000 persons in the police court. He and his force were so successful that the streets of Dawson became as safe as those of an eastern city.

Still, proving many people naughty won't demonstrate whether the bearing of all persons was wise or foolish.
