Learned Men Become Wild When Starved for Oxygen

LONDON (AP).—Oxygen starvation produces some extraordinary effects on men ascending high mountains. Professor Bancroft at the Royal Institution recently told his hearers that during one of his ascents, after a height of 18,000 feet had been reached, he noticed one of his party behaving wildly.

At another altitude a highly respectable don indulged in lurid language and there was the case on record of a man suffering from oxygen starvation who had written down his sensations, and as the starvation became acute started getting his spelling faded.

It was characteristic of this starvation that, though the victim would know what to do, as for instance that by moving 20

yards he would get out of danger, he would not do so unless definitely instructed by someone else.

German Shipping Still Far From Pre-War Efficiency

PLYMOUTH, Eng. (AP).—It will be a good many years before the German mercantile fleet attains its pre-war standard, in the opinion of Carl Stimming, director general of the North German Lloyd.

"For some years," Mr. Stimming said on his way home from

a shipping conference in London, "we must be content with the progress we have made up to the present time."

Leader Kiepp, managing director of the Hamburg American line, returning from the same conference, declared there was not the slightest chance of his line resuming its fast pre-war standard of sailings to and from New York for many years. There are no steamers available, he said, and construction costs have risen so high that the building of ships with speed must wait

until the situation improves.
