Small profits realized by growers during the last two seasons have made it necessary to curtail expenses in harvesting the crops, and a wage scale providing for 22 a day for drivers of mowers and rakes and a maximum wage of 23 a day for stackers and others employed was agreed upon at a meeting held a few days ago at Baker.

On account of low prices for their product last year, the number of producers in this section exchanged work during the harvest and threshing season and secured their crops with but small cash outlay. This method of handling the crops will probably be employed again this year.
