PARTRIDGES AT CLOVER CREEK

CLOVER CREEK (Special) — Last winter several Hungarian partridges wintered on Clover creek. This spring and summer they have nested and are raising their young here and some have been sighted as far down as the Homer Bidwell place on Jimmy creek. Up until this time no one had ever seen them and it seemed a mystery from where they had come. But it was found that some had been turned loose on the state farm at Union and had completely disappeared. It is thought they had left the experiment station in search of a place more suitable to their nature. Scarcely their habits are like the grouse, raising their young in the low foothills and as the season advances seek the higher mountains.

The game birds of this section have been quite scarce for the past few years and it is hoped that the partridges will be protected and allowed to multiply. Haying On. They are beginning to hay in this section and it is thought by the last of the week all the first cutting of alfalfa will have been cut. The weather has been ideal so far for this work.

Each Sunday seems to find several from this section camping and fishing on Catherine creek. As well as finding it great sport the quality of fish is excellent this year and some of their catch is being put up for the winter. With the Apple Growers' association packing Royal Anna, formerly sold to canners, and forwarding them with Bings, Lamberts and such Republicans to eastern cities under refrigeration, a total of 12 cars were shipped up to last night. The shipping season, it is expected, will end Wednesday night, with the tonnage reaching 14 cars. Eight cars were shipped last season. The packed cherries have been shipped to New York city, Chicago, Minneapolis and Detroit.
