Performers Hurt in Thrilling Fight, In the "Plunderer."

Tom Santachi, playing the heavy role in the William Fox picture "The Plunderer," now at the Arcade theatre, is an extremely big man. He weighs nearly 200 pounds and is built in proportion. Frank Nixco, playing the lead, is not quite so large, but he is big enough. In an extraordinary fight scene which eventually brings the twisted threads of the story together, Santachi is thrown clear over an office railing and his head crashes through a glass door.

During the filming of the fight, it may be taken for granted, there was no rehearsal and, moreover, no repeats. It was too real right from the beginning.

The fight was more realistic for the reason that at no stage did it become a mere stunt. In the early scenes, Santachi has decidedly the best of it. But as it progresses, the battle becomes a rough and tumble instead of merely a fist fight. They clinch and Mayo starts at indicating. His repeated short-jabs are effective. Time and again the men are on the floor, each apparently unable to strike another blow. Then they rise and go at it again.

The camera has caught the blows, proving beyond doubt that they were not drawn. It was cruel punishment for both men but they stood it and when the last blow was struck, both of them toppled into chairs and called it a day.

While neither was seriously hurt, both men were completely exhausted. The fight had lasted 12 minutes without a halt. This is equal to ten rounds of ring fighting with one minute rests.
