Cummings Makes New Production at Race Track.

When "Hiders Up," Universal all star picture to be shown at the Star theatre commencing Friday was pronounced ready for distribution, Irving Cummings, the director, completed his fourth straight production for Universal. The other three are "Stolen Secrets," "The Dancing Cheat," and "Fools Highway."

This picture was made with an all star cast. Creighton Hale, Geo. Cooper, Robert Brower, Ethel Shannon and Kate Price have principal roles; and Edith York, Charlotte Stevens and Harry Mann have parts of vital but of lesser importance.

The screen story was adapted from the Red Book Magazine story "When Jimmy Comes Marching Home," by Gerald Beaumont, a claimed one of the best fiction writers dealing with sport. It is a story of race track life and is vividly portrayed in the picture.

The race track town's experiences are the basis of the story and he is pictured as the majority of them; really are; hardworking, honest, according to their code and ever ready to do a good turn to the brother who is down on his luck. They give advice according to their knowledge and convictions, even when superior impulse leads them to abandon reasons for a "bunch."

"The Devil's Ghost" featured at Sherrys Theater.

"The Devil's Ghost," which comes to the Sherry theater for two days beginning today, furnishes an admirable vehicle for Lester Cuneo, the star. The story, which is from the imagination of Henry McCarty, is one that combines all the elements that go to make a great motion picture. It has romance, adventure and tense drama. The hero is provided with a unique escape from enemies that would do justice to Sherlock Holmes, yet the main character is just an adventurous New York sportsman with a brave heart and a strongly cultivated sense of humor. The story concerns a youth who goes into the southwest to hunt and incidentally look over some new property he has found. Because of his likeness to an outlaw known as "the devil," he finds himself in a hotbed of excitement wherein he has difficulty many times saving his own life, but in it all he loses his heart to a pretty girl of the hills.

"Common Law" Begins At Arcade on Friday Afternoon.

Commencing Friday and continuing for two days the Arcade theater will offer a picture of H. W. Chambers' widely read novel, "The Common Law." This is a story of an artist's model and life in general in the art studios of modern times and it vividly portrays many of the humiliating indignities to which the models are compelled to submit. There is probably no star in all the realm of the cinema who is better equipped and more suited to the leading role than is lovely Virginia Griffith, who portrays the difficult part with feeling, delicacy and finesse. As Valerie West, the cultured daughter of refined parents, but who has now been thrown upon the world to earn her own living, after many attempts to secure employment she is at last in desperation driven to the studio of a painter to endeavor to secure work as a model. Of course she is quite ignorant of the state of affairs existing among artists and enters assuming that all is as it should be. There is much drama and pathos when the artist, callous to all the finer sensibilities, gruffly orders her to go in the dressing room and take all her clothes off. It is either that or starve. What shall she do? What would you do in such a case? This is one of the most highly dramatic situations that has ever been presented in any screen offering. No one who lays any claims to being at all fair-minded can reasonably condemn Valerie for her decision to accept the situation and comply with the artist's demands, at least anyone who has experienced the terrible torture of hunger would hesitate before "casting the first stone," and herein the story is absolutely true to life, for it is only in fiction that the heroine would righteously and indignantly denounce the artist, stalk majestically and proudly out of the studio, and so nobly forego her only possible chance for bread and butter. This is only one of the dramatic crises, in which the screen drama abounds. Conway Tearle ably enacts the part of the artist, and the highly dramatic role of Quercia is entrusted to Elliott Dexter.

Alaskan Commerce Chambers Celebrate Midnight Excursion.

WASHINGTON (AP) — The three and a half months of daylight in Alaska recently afforded an opportunity for the government railroad in the territory to hold the only "midnight" excursion on record.
