EXPLAINS USE OF TAX STAMP

PORTLAND, Ore. (Special).—In view of the evident confusion existing with reference to the use of revenue stamps under the law as amended by the recent congress and effective July 3 Clyde G. Huntley, collector of internal revenue issued the following statement:

"The only stamp taxes which have been removed are those on promissory notes, drafts and trade acceptances. Stamp denoting payment of tax must still be affixed, and properly cancelled, to bonds of indebtedness at the rate of 5c per \$100; to certificates of stock at 5c and transfers thereof at 2c per \$100; to deeds and conveyances at 50c for each \$500 or fractional part thereof; to custom house entries and withdrawals at from 25c to \$1 each; to proxies at 10c each; to powers of attorney at 25c each; and to steamship tickets to ports outside the United States at the rate of \$1 to \$5 depending upon the cost of the ticket.

"It is probable that banks and others may have a supply of stamps on hand, purchased for use on promissory notes and drafts and for which they will have no further use. They may write or call at my office for a form upon which to make claim for refund. Claims must be presented within four years from date of the purchase of the stamps.

"The Portland office," continued Mr. Huntley, "will carry a full supply of revenue stamps in all denominations, and orders for stamps should be sent to me. Payment for stamps must be by cash, certified check or money order. Collectors of internal revenue are prohibited by law from accepting uncanceled personal checks in payment of stamps."

German Farmer Quits Crops To Raise Fish and Foxes
LUDWIG LUST, Germany, (AP).—The crops of E. Ziemen, an extensive land owner near here, did not pay very well last year, so Ziemen flooded the fields in the fall and this year has been raising fish and doing so well financially that he is planning to extend his home made lakes.

Ziemen has about 1000 lowland acres under water. German carp have done particularly well in the flooded fields, and this year Ziemen expects to gather about 50 tons of fish.

On some of the higher ground of his estate Ziemen has a large tract devoted to the raising of the blue fox.
