YANKEES WORK FOR VICTORY

United States Athletes at Paris Get Off to Good Start in Olympic Water Games.

PARIS (By the Associated Press)—The Americans were strongly entrenched Tuesday on the various fronts of the Olympic bath after notable victories Tuesday in four outstanding branches of competition. The famous Yale crew, the magnet for the greatest crowd that has yet witnessed a rowing competition, easily won in the elimination heat for eight-oared coxed fours, the second course of the Seine river.

Jack Kelly and Paul Costello, the Philadelphia stars, qualified to play in the doubles when they held the championship.

In the evening contests the American girls out-did the men and shared the laurel with the Australian swimmers, who led the Americans to the end of the day's events 24 to 23 points.

Sixteen American boxers in the opening skirmish of battle for ring honors came off with a big share for the first day, while the American team retained their victorious march through the field.

Miss Helen Wills, American champion, won decisively against Mrs. Katherine of England, though Vincent Richards was compelled to go five sets to conquer the Indian Niem.

WOMAN SWIMMERS PLACE U. S. IN SECOND POSITION

PARIS (By the Associated Press)—Upon the completion of two days of the Olympic swimming program Tuesday evening, the United States stood second in the list of 23 nations entered, Australia was first with 24 points, while the United States was behind one point.

America's unrivaled women swimmers piled up 19 points in the 400 meter swim, free style, finishing one, two, three, and were mainly responsible for their country's showing, while the men swimmers failed to earn a single point in the 15,000 meter event, the plain high diver—placing fourth and fifth to add four points to the feminine score.

The United States placed two men out of three semi-finals of the 200-meter breast stroke.

John Farley, Illinois A. C., alone failing to qualify. Robert H. Keston, Illinois A. C. and W. T. Krehbaum, Hawaii, who finished first and second in their respective heats, will have an opportunity to defend the United States in the final.

In the final of the 400-meter race, it was just a question of which of the three American women, Gertrude Ederle, Helen Wainwright or Martha Nordling, would finish first. Miss Nordling, the outsider won. Second place went to Miss Wainwright and Miss Ederle, the favorite, was placed third.

Johnny Weismuller now is looked upon as the last American hope to defeat the Australian marvel, Andrew Charlton, and assist the women swimmers in scoring points for the United States on that the stars and stripes may fly from the topmast of the municipal Olympic stadium. But Charlton, an 18-year-old boy, who several weeks ago was picking cabbage and milking cows in far away Australia, said tonight, "I can swim much faster than I have done so far."
