### HELEN WILLS BACK IN FORM

American Champion Defeats Mrs. Mallory, American Boxers Win in Paris.

Thursday defeated Mrs. Mollie Hurlstid Mallory, former American champion, representing Norway, in the Olympic tennis championship, 6-2, 6-1.

The duel between Miss Wills and Mrs. Mallory was one of the best exhibitions of the tournament. Both players were in better condition than at any time previously this summer in Europe, but the match was a convincing exhibition of the Californian's superiority to the former American champion.

Miss Wills, with a series of crisp crosses returns from behind, often hit softly but crisply at an upward curve to cause Mrs. Mallory to err. Miss Wills, with keen eye and quick anticipation of the play, was usually ready for her opponent's returns and was seldom passed. At times Mrs. Mallory, setting the pace, gave a fine exhibition of back court driving, but for the most part Miss Wills forced her to accept a defensive role.

**American Boxers Win.**  
PARIS, (AP) — With the victory in the welterweight division of A. Mello of Lowell, Mass., over Christensen of Norway, Thursday evening, the United States boxers tallied four straight wins in the Olympic competitions.

Two of these were knockouts and trainer "Spike" Webb wore a wide smile when he went to dinner.

Mello put the Norwegian away in the first round. Though handicapped in height and reach he kept landing short jabs to the head and ribs and finally sent Christensen to the floor for a count of nine. A moment later he sent him down for the full count.

Ben Rochwell, New York, also in the lightweight division, won over Graham, Canada, in a bout in which cleverness was displayed.
