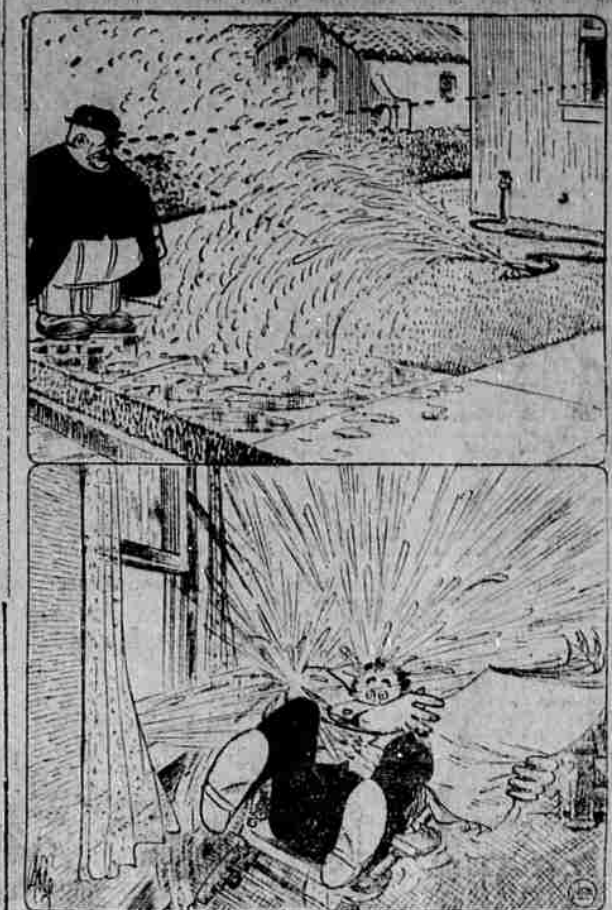

The future famous author was unable to sell his stories in San Francisco, and one day he disappeared mysteriously without bidding any of us farewell. That he was a writer of great merit whose work was not newspaper work, he amply evidenced. His assignments were unimportant and he infinitely preferred to wander about Chinatown, to "do" funerals and society functions. It was two or three years later after the name of Kipling had created a tremendous stir in the literary world by the publication of "The Light that Failed" and others of his superb stories, that we who had known him casually in San Francisco recalled him to memory. He left San Francisco presumably on a fishing trip and as far as I am aware, he never visited that city again.

Reporters Tells of Rudyard Kipling Who Wrote Movie Coming.

(By Charles Kenmore Ulrich) It was my good fortune to be a reporter on the San Francisco "Chronicle" in 1923 when Rudyard Kipling, then about 24 years old, who had just arrived from India, became a member of the reporter staff. Everything about him betrayed the man from the Orient, but what impressed me most was his pronounced accent, his stocky frame, heavy bulging eyebrows and great nostrils. He was in no sense a "finkster," so that his coarse and coarse during his stay were scarcely observed by those with whom he came in casual contact.

Mr. Kipling's connection with the "Chronicle" was extremely brief—less than a month. I then lived at No. 608 Bush street in the house Robert Louis Stevenson occupied during his stay in San Francisco in the winter of 1879-80. Mr. Kipling roomed somewhere along that street and several times we walked home in company after our final copy had been turned in at night. On one of these occasions he asked
