FIGHTERS ARE READY TODAY

Georges Carpentier and Gene Tunney Concluded Training Yesterday; Fight Tonight.

NEW YORK (AP) — Georges Carpentier, French light heavyweight, and Gene Tunney, American light heavyweight champion, concluded their training Wednesday for their scheduled 12-round match at the Polo grounds tonight. Each tipped the scales under the 175-pound weight limit. They are in the best of shape for the match.

Carpentier, 26 years old, meets in Tunney, 25, a fighter who excels in height and reach; the other physical measurements being virtually the same. Tunney is a stiff, left-handed puncher, while Carpentier is more agile with his right than his left hand.

The match, exceedingly popular from a box office standpoint, despite Carpentier's defeat at the hands of Tommy Gibbons in Michigan City on May 31, is expected to draw close to 50,000 spectators. Promoters said Wednesday the preliminaries are scheduled for 7:15 o'clock eastern standard time. Under the New York boxing laws the main bout must get under way not later than 9 o'clock.

Copper Dust Controls Smut.

Wheat smut has yielded to control by copper carbonate dust, according to investigations by the experiment station. The cost, the labor and the risk are less than for treatment with liquid lime-sulfur or formaldehyde. Fewer seeds are damaged by the chemicals and hence one-fourth less seed is ample for a good stand. The plants germinate better under unfavorable conditions of drought and emerge much stronger and more vigorous.

ARMY BROKEN BY DISEASE

Death from Contagious Played Havoc with Gen. Townsend's Force.

LONDON (AP) — A vivid description of the hardships suffered by General Townsend's army at the siege of Kut-el-Amara during the World War is given in the British Medical History of the war, 11 volumes of which have just been completed and published. Scoury, dysentery and malaria were prevalent, and many men actually died of starvation.

The army's rations early in March of 1916 consisted of 16 ounces of bread, one pound four ounces of meat, and one ounce of jam, half an ounce of salt, half an ounce of ginger, two ounces of oatmeal and one and a half ounces of dates to the man. For the Indian troops the rations consisted of 16 ounces of barley flour, four ounces of unhusked barley, one ounce of chick, half an ounce of ginger, half an ounce of turmeric, eight ounces of meat and one and a half ounces of dates. This was just over the subsistence diet for the British troops, and just under it for the Indians, and an epidemic of scurvy resulted.

During the latter part of March and early in April the rations were further decreased, and many of the men began to suffer acutely from hunger. Two pounds of opium were obtained by airplane and one grain pill was given by the surgeons in selected cases to ameliorate the intensity of the pain. Sugar was not obtainable, and as the supply of morphine was small, it was used only for hospital cases.

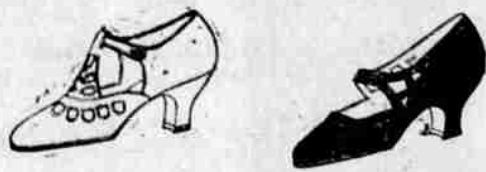

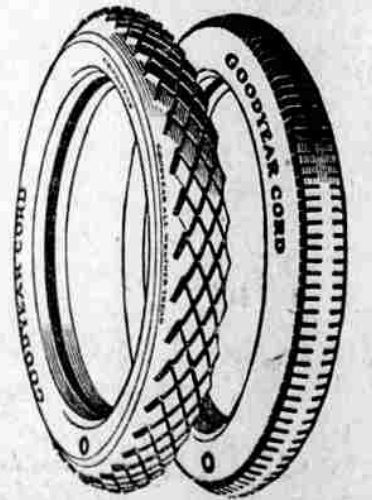
