LONDON (AP)—When Admiral
Sir Doveton Sturdee's naval squad-
ron defeated the German squad-
ron off the Falkland islands in the

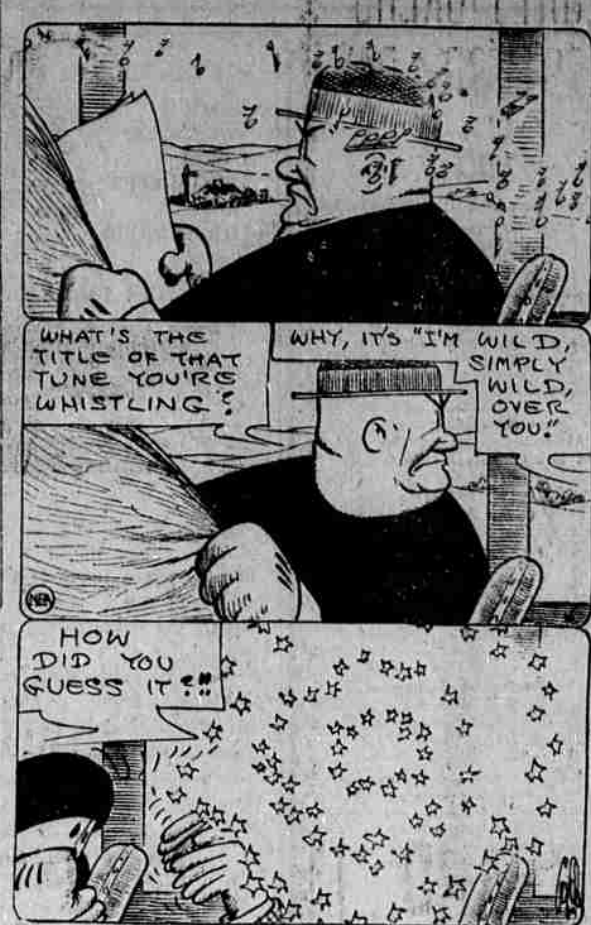

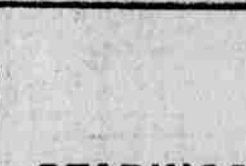
