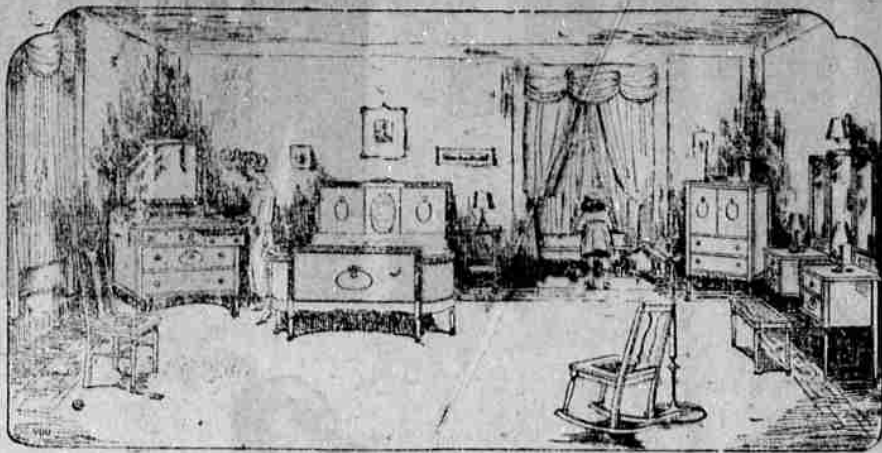

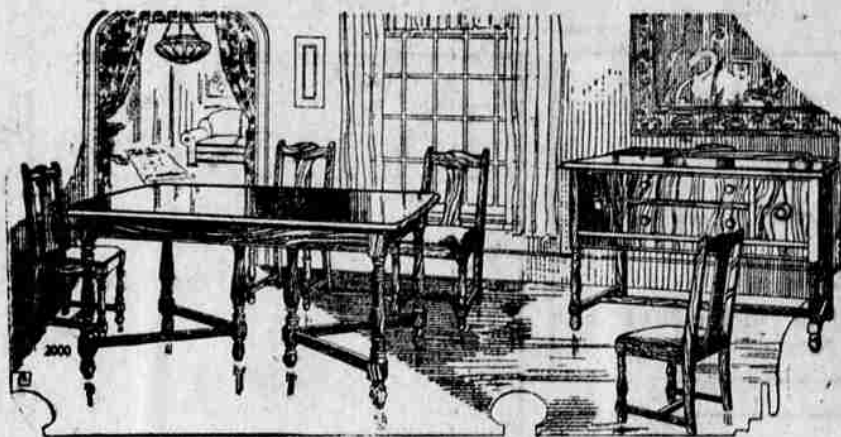

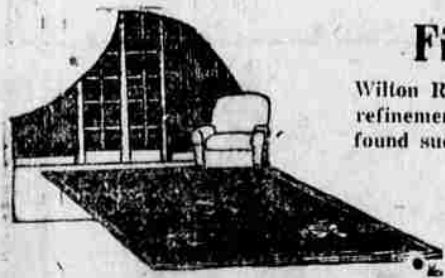

LONDON, (AP).—Miss Alice Astor, daughter of Lady Ribblesdale and the late John Jacob Astor, Thursday married Prince Nicholas, son of the Russian Emperor, in a quiet ceremony at the home of the bride's mother.

Prince Nicholas, 22, is a descendant of one of the oldest families of czarist Russia. His ancestors can be traced back to 17th century, founder of the Russian monarchy.

Miss Astor is a sister of Vincent Astor, the business magnate of New York, and at that time came into possession of the \$1,000,000 trust fund created for her by her father.

Many Spanish Teachers Desert Jobs for Better Paying Work

MADRID, (AP).—A movement for higher salaries for teachers in the universities and technical high schools has been inaugurated in Spain. The professors, it is pointed out by The Liberal, receive an average of 4,000 pesetas annually, or about the same as an ordinary clerk in an office.
