



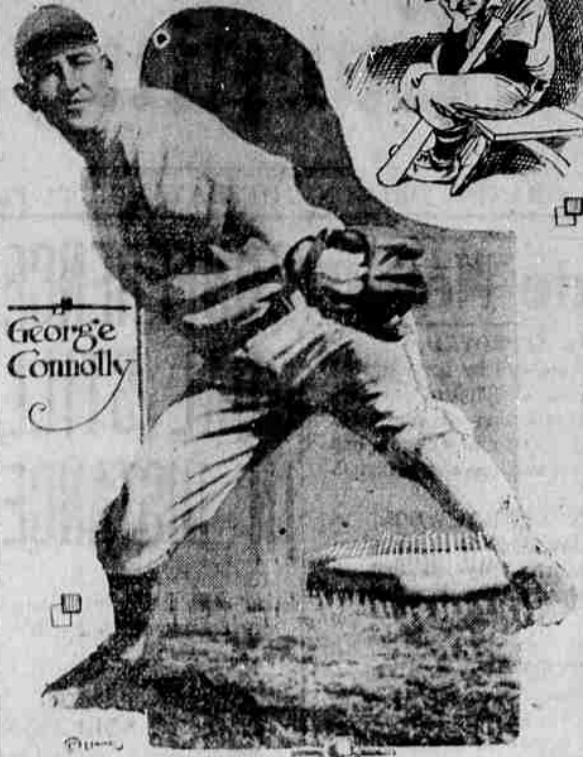

### TENNESSEE TO ELECT CHIEF

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP).—Qualified voters of Tennessee will on August 7 cast their ballots for the candidates of their choice in two state primaries, a judicial election and local primaries in the various counties.

Both Democrats and Republicans will stage primary elections for state offices. Two members of the supreme court, Judge W. L. Cook of Charlotte, and Judge A. W. Chambliss of Chattanooga and two court of appeals justices, Judge Arthur Crowder, of Winchester and Judge R. A. Davis, of Athens, all appointed to office during the administration of Governor Peay, are to be voted upon.

There is no opposition in the county judges. Governor Austin Peay, retiring on the last month of his term, has no successor.

### SPORT NEWS

#### SOCCER SPORT OF THE SOUTH

BUENOS AIRES (AP).—The surprise expressed in the United States and Europe that a little country like Uruguay should have produced a football team capable to win the Olympic championship is not shared in South America.

Just as in the United States boys learn to play baseball as soon as they can lift a bat, boys in Argentina, Uruguay, Chile, Paraguay and Brazil learn to play soccer football when they are five or six.

In all these countries football is the national sport, and it is considered no wonder that in Uruguay, or in any of these, world champions could be produced as the result of the universal devotion to this game.

Senior football was introduced into the River Plate countries by the English 20 years ago and took an immediate hold. Since that time crack English and Scotch teams have come to the River Plate and gone down in defeat, as well as teams from Italy, Spain and Czechoslovakia.

They found that they had nothing to teach the South Americans, either in the science of the game, or in skill and sportsmanship.

For the past seven years, annual South American football championship contests have been held which rival the world baseball series in the United States in popular interest. One championship final between Argentina and Uruguay played in Buenos Aires drew an attendance of 65,000 persons. Of the seven championships won by Uruguay, Uruguay has won four, Brazil two, and Argentina one.

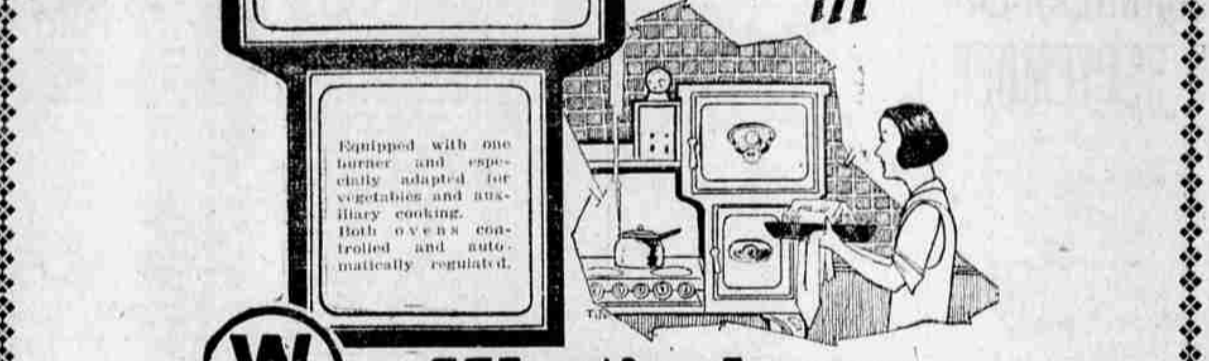

### Examine The Oven

Most of the cooking on an electric range is done in the ovens, as it is easier and more economical. The smaller oven is fitted with one heating element. The larger has two, either or both of which may be utilized. The one at the bottom of the oven for most ordinary cooking, the one at the top for broiling, and as an auxiliary.

Each oven is equipped with the necessary pans, and racks, and a heat reflector. These as well as the heating elements can be removed for cleaning. The oven interior itself is finished in a blue vitreous enamel, as hard as the enamel on a bath tub, and so may be scrubbed with soap and water, and a condition of immaculate cleanliness attained.

Packed around the ovens is an insulating material known as mineral wool, which has remarkable heat retaining qualities. As a consequence, all heat is confined in the ovens and the kitchen remains cool and comfortable.
