In Favor of Drinking
DUBLIN (AP). - St. Patrick's day in the Free State is not so dry. The Bill, despite the urgent appeals of Vice President O'Higgins, has decided by a vote of 59 to 23 that it shall allow all other week days, except Christmas day and Good Friday, for a 12-hour drinking day.
The compromise proposal to treat the day as a Sunday, when drink may be sold for a few fixed hours, did not find support. As Mr. O'Higgins put it "There were three ways of honoring St. Patrick's day, one by getting drunk, one by keeping sober, and a third by getting half drunk," and he left the decision between them to the free vote of the Deil.
