GAME BODY IS GIVEN SETBACK

Deer Shooting Will Be on Basis Fixed by Statute as Result of Decision.

SALEM, Ore. (City the Associated Press)—A decision of the Marion county circuit court overruling a demurrer against an injunction granted by the court to Walter Winslow restraining the state game commission from changing the dates of the deer season in Oregon was affirmed and the injunction made permanent by the supreme court here today Tuesday. The decision written by Justice Coshow affirms Judge George G. Bingham of the Marion circuit court.

Emergency Not Shown
After declaring that the game commission had not shown an emergency to exist such as would warrant the temporary abrogation of the state law fixing the dates, the court holds that the change constituted the assumption of legislative power without warrant, declaring "no case has been cited by the defendants (the game commission) supporting such a delegation of legislative power. We have been unable to find a case going to that extent. Indeed, defendant contends that the petition cannot deprive the legislature of power conferred upon it by the constitution. It follows, therefore, that the circuit court did not err in overruling the demurrer."

TENNIS PLAY IS BRILLIANT

BEARHIGHT, N. J. (AP)—As the best tennis invitation tennis tournament narrowed down to eight survivors in the men's singles Tuesday there was only one real surprise, the defeat of Clarence J. Griffin of San Francisco, twelfth in national rank, by Nathaniel W. Niles of Boston, who rates eighteenth. Niles won, but through superior tennis, but through superior condition. He had more in reserve in the third set and came through by a small margin of 6-4, 5-6, 6-4. With the rallies sharp and well sustained Griffin was almost exhausted at the end.

The close of the second day's play found four Californians were still unbeaten—William M. Johnston, Harvey Broadman, Howard Kinsey and Walter Westbrook. Lavier Williams of Chicago, Nathaniel Niles of Boston, Dean Malloy of Cranford, N. J., and Alexander D. Thayer of Philadelphia, were the other four survivors. Thayer advanced through the defeat of Robert Kinsey of San Francisco, whose injured shoulder bothered him considerably.

Johnston was extended by Rock Wright of the Canadian Davis cup team to 6-2, 7-5, but easily proved his superiority at important stages. Johnston took three sets in short order in the first set after Wright had earned a lead of 6-2, by brilliant court coverage.

Howard Kinsey, Pacific coast champion in the most spectacular match of the day, came from behind to beat Frank Norton, the former South African, in 6-4, 6-4, 6-2.

Lavier Williams, former intercollegiate champion, eliminated Willard Crocker, the second Canadian internationalist, by scores of 1-6, 4-1, 7-5. Dean Malloy outplayed Jerome Langlo after a close first set.

Mary K. Brown of California, Molly D. Thayer of Philadelphia and Florence Ballin and Mayne MacDonald of New York, reached the semi-finals in the women's singles. Miss Brown had the easiest time advancing, yielding only two games to Miss Anna Fuller of Boston. Miss Thayer was forced to extra sets by Miss Huff and Miss Ballin by Margaret Blake.

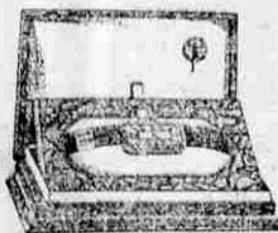
