GEO. CLEAVER PROBE LIKELY

SALISBURY, Ore. (Special)—Because of some question having been raised as to the correctness of figures contained in the semi-annual report of George L. Cleaver, state prohibition director, relation to the financial achievements of the department during the six months period ending June 30 of this year, Governor Pierce probably will be requested to order an investigation of the report, based on the records now on file in the office of the secretary of state and state treasurer.

In Mr. Cleaver's report it was indicated that the activities of the state prohibition department had returned to the state through fines and seizures, approximately \$77,000, while in fact this was the amount of the fines imposed by the courts and not the amount of fines actually collected. The collection of fines, according to the records, did not exceed \$15,000, while attached to the conduct of the department was approximately \$15,000.

Members of the legislature who have been in close touch with the operation of the prohibition department under Mr. Cleaver said today that unless Governor Pierce orders an investigation of the finances of the bureau the probe will be requested in a resolution to be introduced early in the 1925 legislative session.

Berlin Owners Begin to Mend Their War Neglected Homes BERLIN (AP)—Scars of the 1918 revolution and other reminders of the war and its aftermath reflected in neglected public buildings as well as private dwellings and apartment houses in Berlin, are to be blotted out this summer.

Throughout Berlin thousands of workmen have begun the task of repairing buildings which have been neglected eight or ten years, and which have suffered visibly from the effects of the weather. The work has been taken up particularly in the residential sections, where a great many hand-lords for years have made no endeavor to keep up the appearance of their property because of the lack of income from their holdings.

But since the mark has been stabilized, apartment house owners have taken a new lease in life and started the long-delayed improvements, the law having been adjusted so that now house owners have an income from their real estate nearly equaling that prior to 1914.

It has cost the Indian fund between \$1000 and \$1500, the agent says, but how much damage was done will have to be computed later.
