**Harold Lloyd's "Girl Shy" Coming This Week.**

Harold Lloyd is now a producer. In addition to being the world's foremost screen comedian, Lloyd is introduced to the public also as one of the leading producers of the industry in his most recent feature picture comedy, "Girl Shy," which will be shown at the Arcade Theatre starting Wednesday.

With "Girl Shy," Lloyd gives to the public his initial independent production, "Why Worry?" and from all accounts, it will establish him as high in the producing field as he stands in the acting plane.

With only a few exceptions, the most staff that has assisted Lloyd in the making of such triumphs as "Why Worry?" "Safety Last," and "Dr. Jack," were associated with the spectacular comedian in the production of "Girl Shy."
