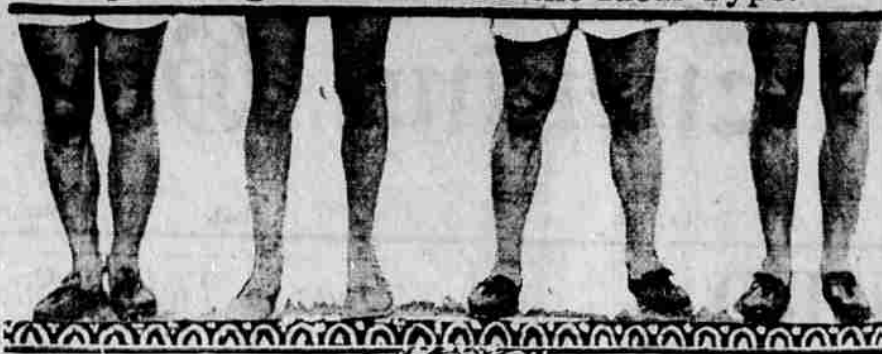

## WALLOWA FOREST CLOSED

PORTLAND, Ore., (Special)—The entire Wallowa national forest in Oregon and the watersheds of two streams in Oregon and Washington were closed to the public yesterday by order of George H. Cecil, district forester at the Portland office.

Danger to the forests yesterday was about the same as it has been for a week. Of about 50 fires which were started in the district Sunday night by lightning, all were brought out or under control yesterday. Weather conditions were practically unchanged, although reports from the Selkirk national forest in northeastern Washington indicated dangerous lack of humidity and high winds.

## Five Fires Near Baker

BAKER, Ore., (By the Associated Press)—Five new fires are reported in the Whitman national forest and adjoining timber. The most serious of these is in an accessible region four miles north of Anthony lake, about 20 miles northwest of Baker.

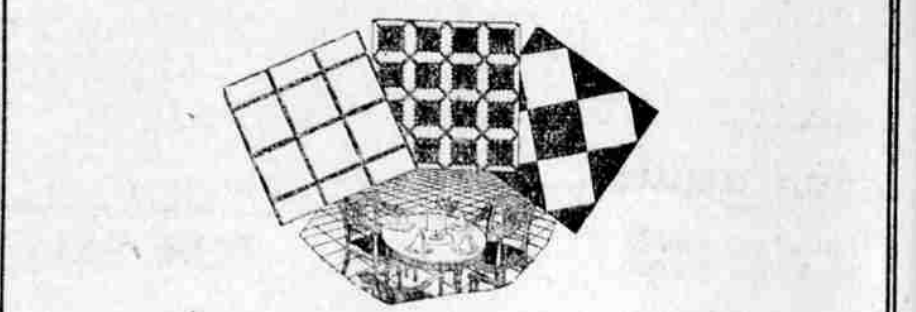
