SEACADA PRUNES SOLD. OREGON CITY, Ore.—Prunegrover of Seacada and vicinity have contracted with McNeil and Libby of The Dalles for about 200 tons of prunes for canning and 500 tons of prunes have been contracted with Boehl and Day of New York through the Portland, Ore., office. The fruit will be harvested at Seacada just as soon as the sugar appears in the prunes white on the trees.

It is estimated that there will be harvested 1000 tons of green prunes in the vicinity of Seacada this year.

Those who have contracted their prunes to the canneries will receive \$28 a ton, and those furnishing fruit to the New York firm will receive 60 cents and up per box.
