LOS ANGELES (AP) - Forty million more people attended Southern California theatres and places of amusements in the last fiscal year than during the year previous, according to figures compiled by the Collector of Internal Revenue here.

During the year ended June 30, 1924, the total attendance at places of amusement was 191,443,072 as compared with 151,298,666 for the year terminated June 30, 1923. The number of persons attending theatres and similar places of recreation is disclosed by the admission tax, which amounted to \$3,180,718 in 1923-24, as against \$2,552,444 for the previous fiscal year, an increase of \$633,074.

Democrats of South Carolina To Select Complete Ticket

COLUMBIA, S. C. (AP) - With nomination by the Democratic party in this state equivalent to election, South Carolina Democrats will go to the polls, August 26, to choose a complete ticket, from United States senator down through the smallest county offices.

Principal public interest is held by the contest for nomination as United States senator. Senator N. B. Dial, of Laurens, who is completing his first term and is seeking re-election, has three opponents. Congressman James P. Byrnes, of Aiken, who was elected to the 62nd and each succeeding congress, is one of them.

Governor Thomas G. McLeod, serving his first term, is opposed by John T. Duncan, a Columbia lawyer, who has offered for the

last 20 years. Lieutenant Governor Edmund B. Jackson, of Waggoner, is unopposed for reelection. The race for congress will be run in five districts.

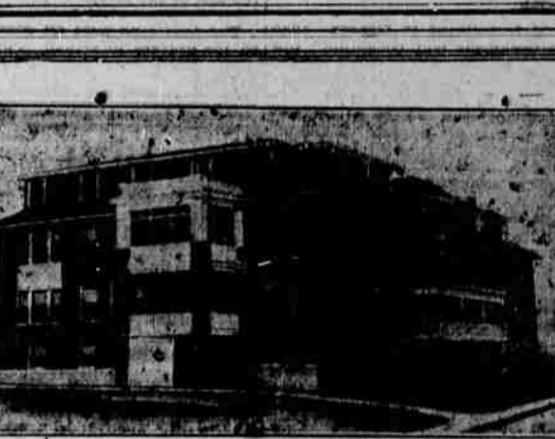
Profits Dines on \$,000. Fish. COPENHAGEN, (AP) - Almost \$,000 little fish were devoured by a female dolphin at one meal, according to Dr. J. Schmidt, one of the best known ichthyologists of Denmark. Dr. Schmidt had this dolphin caught off the Spanish coast in the Mediterranean and then examined its stomach. He found in it 15,191, ear bones, of which every fish has two. Dr. Schmidt established the fact that these bones belonged to five varieties of fish that made up the dolphin's meal.
