TAYLOR WINS TOURNAMENT

WHISKY CREEK HAS A WRECK

WALLOWA, Ore. (Special) — The Gastin threshing outfit was badly wrecked at the H. J. Conner farm on Whiskey creek recently. The machine was being moved from one setting to another part of the field. While going down a steep hill some part of the engine gave way allowing the separator and engine to run away. Mr. Conner and John Anderson, who was steering the engine, were able to guide the runaway outfit for a few hundred feet, when the separator upset while going over some rough ground. The engine was broken off the machine and many other parts badly damaged. The owners state that they will not attempt to repair the damaged parts but have ordered a new outfit, which they expect to arrive in a few days. The new outfit will include a sixty horsepower gasoline engine, and a large size Russell separator.

Farmers are taking advantage of the fair weather and are getting their crops harvested rapidly. The Royal threshing outfit has been thrashing the fall wheat crop of lower valley during the past week. The yield is said to have been very good from several of the crops in that section, ranging from 18 to 25 bushels per acre. Several of the farmers in the Leap section about ten miles east of here, are cutting their crops with combines. The yields here are reported to be between 15 and 18 bushels per acre.

Mr. Helms and family moved to the Minor farm the first of the week where they will work for H. C. Dougs during harvest.

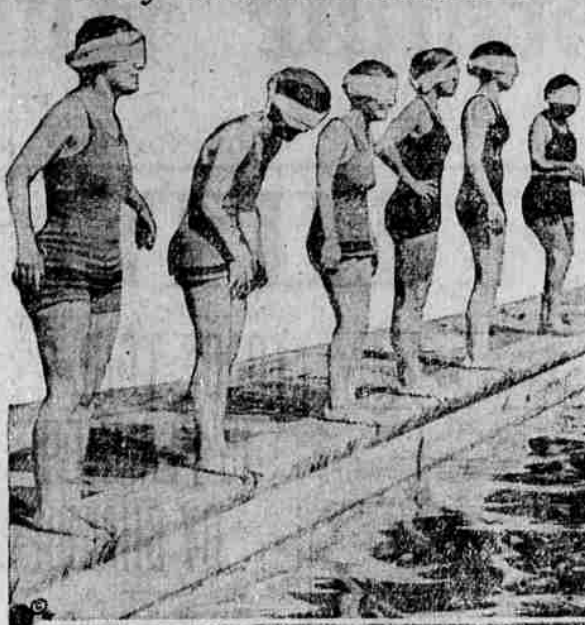
T. P. Lathrop came from Chilo the first of the week to help his brothers L. V. and Duane with their harvest work.

FINE CLOTHES ARE DISLIKED

LONDON. (AP) — The Labor party has achieved success in society if not in parliament, since it came into power, writes the Liberal Magazine, in a caustic article in its July issue. The publication says: "In every avenue of polite and decorative social display the Labor government has been a tremendous success. No opportunity has been missed. There has never been a moment's slackness in any matter of garden parties, royal receptions, court balls, city banquets or special opera performances in Covent Garden. Even the special admiralty yacht the Eucharistos, which the late Conservative government laid aside from motives of narrow parsimony, has been brought out again for the use of Labor ministers and their friends. "And there has been no nonsense about dress. The wives and daughters of ministers have not only taken the trouble to go to court on two consecutive nights, but have worn entirely different and quite suitable clothes on each occasion. The prime minister has been so obliging as to allow himself to be seen in the city in blue velvet and gold braid."

"All the same, it has been an immense triumph for the Labor party. No one can ever again accuse them of 'unreasonable' hospitality to that lavish social display which gives so much pleasure to poor people who have to watch it from the pavement. If they had done as well in parliament as they have done in society—but, after all, it is not fair to ask too much."

PUBLIC LIKES 'BLACK GOLD'

Racer Held in High Esteem by Fond Backers; Too Many Affections Showered on Horse.

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — Too much nobility may affect the turf career of Black Gold, as it finally ruined famous Old Rosebud, ten years ago, in the opinion of Kentucky turf experts who see in the public clamor for the Hoots colt many of the possibilities which brought stardom to Old Rosebud. Not since 1914, when Old Rosebud won the Kentucky Derby and set the record for the race at 2:02 2-5, has there been a horse kind so high in public esteem. Lovers of horseflesh are showering their affections on this black son of Black Tom and the little Indian pony, Ussett.

Texas and three years later he came back and beat Hoamer and other leaders. He was so popular he was "aced to death" and was destroyed two years ago.

For several years no horse received the admiration that was Old Rosebud's. Black Gold made a bid for it last winter when he won the Louisiana Derby at New Orleans. He was the favorite in the Kentucky Derby and came from behind to win the fiftieth renewal of that classic. He went on to Cleveland and annexed his third derby, the Ohio event. His first reversal came in the Latonia Derby a short time later, when Challoway and Gillon romped home ahead of him. Like the only race Man O'War ever lost, turf enthusiasts still are trying to explain how it happened. Black Gold obtained revenge by beating Gillon six lengths in the Chicago Derby. He thus equaled the record made in 1912 by Claude, the only other horse that ever won our derbies in a year.

A chance to win five derbies in a single season slipped by at Ashland, Ky., when Bob Tail and Al-lwood beat Black Gold, the favorite, by a nose. Turf experts began to wonder if Black Gold was not being raced too often to satisfy the demands of the public. Unlike famous thoroughbreds of old, Black Gold was not bred in the purple. There is some doubt as to his mother's blue blood. Ussett belonged to an Indian, Al
