KILLS BEAR AT THE PARK

Louis Van Pelt Kills a Large Bear Weighing 500 Pounds.

THE PARK (Special)—A large black bear weighing about 500 pounds was killed just below the Big Steadocks, Friday, the 27th Louis Van Pelt, from the Umphire reservation, did the killing. Mr. Van Pelt was with a party of Indian hunters, directed by Gilbert Sturthorn. When they came upon the tracks of the animal Gilbert gave the necessary instructions in placing the men in position. Soon the bear was sighted by Louis, who with a .26 Remington rifle, placed a well aimed bullet behind its ear.

The great was taken to camp on the Hunter homestead at the Park. Gilbert, assisted by several Indians, cooked the meat in Indian style. The meat was placed in a hole in the ground and buried with hot rocks and coals. In this way, the bear meat is most excellent. This was done in the night so that the flies don't bother while preparing the meat.
