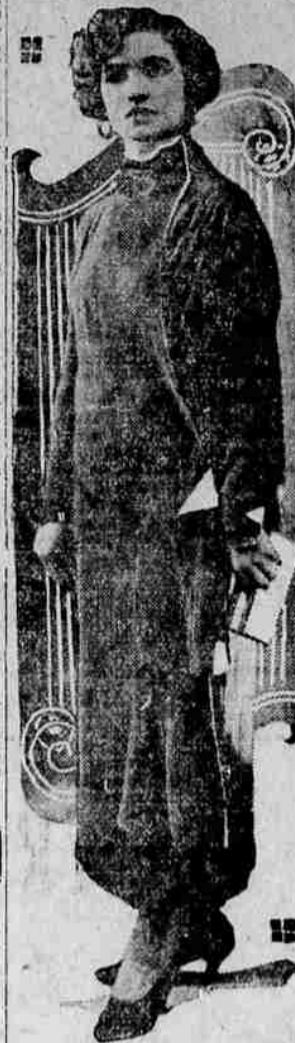

Folks down east seem some such political connection in the action of the Treasury Department in putting back into circulation several millions of the huge and heavy old "cart-wheel" silver dollars which have lain for years deep down in the treasury vaults.

Through the west silver dollars have never lost favor as a circulating medium. Any kind of dollars there have been most welcome.

Reindeer Expected to Provide Major Industry for Alaska

NOME, Alaska. (AP)—Extensive preparations have been made to place Alaska's reindeer industry this fall on a par with fox-raising, furs, fishing and sheep raising in the territory, according to Carl J. Lomen, president of a trading corporation.

Mr. Lomen explained that despite the fact that many natives are very wealthy on paper, due to their large reindeer herds, they are nearly starving. The herds have increased to a point where they must be depleted. The one sure way, without waste, is to cultivate a taste for reindeer meat, not only throughout Alaska, but in the United States and in foreign countries.

Natives of American Samoa Want Their Status Defined

PAGO PAGO, American Samoa. (AP)—The recommendation of Secretary of State Hughes that the sovereignty of the United States be extended over Swain's Island was reported here by radio when President Coolidge sent it to the Senate. It caused surprise, and raised the question of the status of American Samoa.

Swain's Island, known as Otouana to the Samoans, lies north of Samoa. Originally it was a coral atoll and was built up by the energy of the original settlers and their descendants. Many shiploads

Thus far the islands are known to Congress as "the United States naval station, Tutuila." The naval station is at Pago Pago and the country outside, though styled part of the station for some purposes, has nothing to do with it in other respects, and this had led to confusion.
