Prize Fight One Of Features in "Great White Way."

At last there is something new on the screen. It is "The Great White Way" which opened Sunday at the Sherry theatre, where it was received much in the manner of a conquering hero by the hundreds who packed the place. And it was a reception well deserved.

This latest million-dollar film from the Hearst studio pen-pot-pourri of the high lights of sport, the stage, and Broadway during the past year. It can be compared to the musical comedy revue having the added feature of the personal appearance of celebrities.

It concerns all those things that New Yorkers, sophisticated and unsophisticated, like to talk about. It is starred with a lavishly hand-picked cast. In fact, the entire "Ziegfeld Follies" company, with Ned Wayburn showing the way.

Then we are introduced to a number of personages, who have been made famous by the Hearst publications or who have made the Hearst publications famous. They include Arthur Brisbane, who demonstrated his versatility as an actor; Billy De Beck, originator of Barney Google and Spark Plug; and the better known sports writers and cartoonists of those far-reaching papers. A grand advertising stunt!

Doubtless the producers of this picture have taken as their model, "Hollywood," in which all the celebrities of screenland come out to say hello. "The Great White Way" however, is handicapped in that those persons it brings before the camera are not so well known.

The story was written by H. C. Witwer, and concerns Cain and Abel, characters he has made popular through his stories. Cain is a prize fighter and Abel is the leading lady in a Broadway musical comedy. A press agent, and a convincing one at that, brings about a romance.

Oscar Shaw, who plays Cain, seems to be a real leather pusher. Our program informs us that he went into training for three months before he could undertake the part. Anita Stewart plays Abel. T. Roy Barnes, as the enterprising press agent, furnishes most of the laughs.

Others in the cast are Tom Lewis, Olin Howland, Dore Davidson, Hal Korda and Stanley Fred.

"Men." Pola Negri's new Paramount picture, written and directed by the Russian producer, Dimitri Buchowetzki, the man who made "Peter the Great" was shown for the first time in La Grande at the Arcade theatre yesterday. It's a great dramatic story of modern France, a tale of love and regeneration.

Pola plays the role of "Chloe," waitress in a shore front cafe in Marseilles. And what a role it is! Here's the Pola of old European productions, the Pola of "Dance" and the rest, Pola in a picture that is going to make the screen world sit up and take notice—take a new interest in life. Robert Frazer has the leading male role opposite the star. Robert Edeson and Joseph Swickard also have important parts. Others in the strong supporting cast of the production include Monte Colton, Gino Corrado and Edgar Norton. Emil Berni, who wrote the scenario for Ernest Lubitsch's "The Marriage Circle," made the adaptation. Alvin Wycoff handled the photography.

"Men" will remain at the Arcade theatre today and Wednesday.
