## Farthest North Sea Fishing Banks to Be Developed by Russia

ARCHANGEL, Russia. (AP).—Soviet Russia has made strenuous efforts this summer to develop her sea fisheries as a source of food supply, and in this connection, it was announced recently, new fishing grounds have been discovered off Jugurski Schar in Arctic waters adjacent to Russia. The new fishing banks were located quite by accident. It was during a cruise of the steamship Malgina, of 1500 tons, with Russian sea scientists aboard who were doing research work for the purpose of studying matters pertaining to the biological, hydrographical and meteorological problems of the polar regions encountered. Further investigations in the same waters, off Jugurski Schar, revealed that the fish "made their homes" there in great numbers. This is said to be the most northerly fishing banks in the world.

There are indications, not only on the Archangel coast, but in Northern Norway as well, that the Russian interests are going in for deep sea fishing on a much larger scale than at any time since the revolution. Formerly the "Russian trade" was a main feature of such Norwegian towns as Vardo and Hammerfest. As far back as the fifteenth century the Pomors fished and traded along the Norwegian coast. Gradually in the eighteenth century the fishing, passed into Norwegian hands, the Russians confining their attention to the purchase and shipping of the catches. In the five years ending in 1912, more than 149,000 tons were thus purchased, much of this going to England. With the war and the revolution this trade vanished, but now Russia has begun to buy fishing craft in Norway with which to catch her own fish, thus bringing about a great saving for the Russian people.

Many Jobless in Nippon TOKIO (AP) — Unemployment is increasing in Japan, according to figures compiled by government employment offices. During June 86,000 men applied to these offices for work, an increase of 100 percent over the figures for June, 1923. Industrial depression and the effects of the earthquake are blamed.
