YANKEES WIN AT BEAN CITY

The Yankees gained half a game on Washington yesterday when they defeated Boston 5 to 4 while the Washington-Baltimore game was postponed owing to rain. Detroit won the only other game in the American league 7 to 3 from Chicago.

In the National League Brooklyn was inactive, as was New York, because of rain. Chicago used out-inning 4 to 3 and St. Louis defeated the Philadelphia Phillies twice in a double-header.

In the Pacific Coast league Oakland, still leading in 65 percent column, won twice from Vernon and Los Angeles and San Francisco 7 to 1 and 10 to 0 after winning a non-official benefit game Monday. Los Angeles won and Portland's appeal gave the former team leadership of the second division. Salt Lake won from Sacramento in the other game.

His application has been filed by the Boundary County Fish and Game association, which favors game preserve. Mr. Kloehnman asserts he is not a fisherman or hunter, but desires to see wild game protected around him.

TROY MOST EXPENSIVE TOWN

MORGAN, Ind. — While county and state taxes remain about stationary, city and city taxes show steady increases, although Lafay county has the lowest levy of any in the state, according to Auditor Harry Chetober. Troy is the most expensive community, with 49 cents of its tax dollar going for municipal government. Lafayette is second, with 46 cents; Moway and Rivall, third, with 44 cents each.
