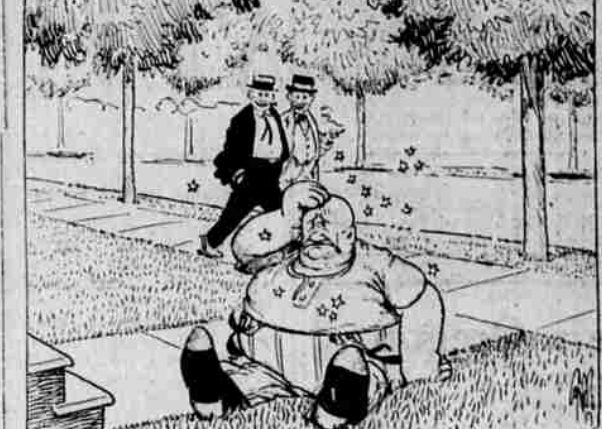

BABE RUTH TO COME TO WEST
 Will Play in Portland, Tacoma, San Francisco and Other Coast Cities

NEW YORK—It appears that a Babe Ruth stampede is under way on the Pacific Coast.
 The Elks at Portland, Ore., and the American Legion at Tacoma, Wash., are the latest to send the home run king an invitation.
 The Babe Ruth movement started last week when the San Francisco Examiner wired the big boy an invitation to assist its annual Christmas charity fund by playing an exhibition game on October 25. No sooner had the king of swat dispatched his royal acceptance, than similar invitations arrived from the Knights of Columbus at Los Angeles and likewise from a newspaper in Santa Barbara, Cal.

The only definite date set is for October 25 in San Francisco. Other dates depend on the last game of the world series, which the Babe hopes to attend in the same capacity as 1923. At any rate he will leave for the West immediately after the last game, going to the Pacific Coast via the Northwest and playing in scheduled cities en route to San Francisco. From that point he will proceed to Southern California, noted for its climate and moving picture studios.

Accepts Portland Date.
 The telegram sent to the Portland Elks is as follows:
 "August 27, 1924—To Joe Reisch, exalted ruler; Judge W. A. Elwell, Frank J. Loneragan, committee. B. P. O. Elks Lodge, Portland, Ore.: Sure I will play in Portland but I'll be willing to knock a home run for the Portland Elks even in a billboard, that is, if I don't strike out. Anyway, I appreciate your invitation and hope to meet you in October." (Signed)—"BABE RUTH."

In Tacoma the American Legion got on the job, and not content with an invitation by wire, they pressed into special service John Quinn, whose home is in California, is now on an Eastern tour of inspection and happened to be in New York City. He made a special trip to the Yankee stadium to invite the king of swat on behalf of the legionnaires in Tacoma. The commander was successful.
