Cast Made of Largest Bird Ever Traced by Scientists

LOS ANGELES, Cal. (AP)—A plaster cast reproduction of the largest bird ever known to have existed, has been unveiled at the Los Angeles museum. Its scientific title is "Teratornis merriami," the name honoring Dr. John C. Merriam, president of the Carnegie Institute, who was instrumental in its discovery at the Rancho La Brea pits near here. From these pits have come many fossil bones of birds and beasts of the pleistocene period. Another place the age of the bones of this bird is 25,000 years. The "teratornis" nearest living relative is the California condor, but few of these remain today.

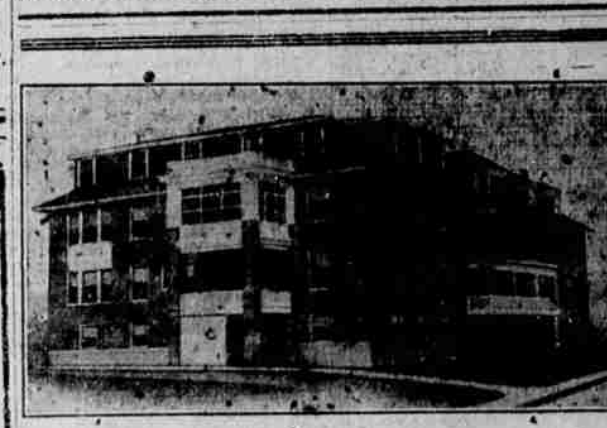
