SPIRITS BEAT AIRMEN, CLAIM

TOKIO (AP).—In fortune which attended the attempt of A. Stuart MacLaren, British round-the-world aviator, and his companions to fly across the remainder of the globe after leaving Japan, is attributed by the natives of Uru island, one of the black Kuriles, to the airman's own indifference to evil spirits.

When Major MacLaren's big Vickers amphibian hopped off from Toshihimo, Yotorofu island, one day in July, with Paramushiro island, at the north of the Kurile chain, as his goal, fog and wind compelled him to land at Tokotan bay, on the southwest coast of Uru island. The bay is exposed, and when the wind rose Major MacLaren flew his plane in short distance inland, alighting on a body of brackish water known as Tokotan Bog. In so doing, according to the sparse population of Uru island, he courted the malevolence of evil spirits.

Tokotan Bog is an ill-omened water. The natives say it is bottomless, and that no man has ever entered its water, and come out alive. There is an evil for male spirit, the natives believe, who hawks a specialty of hand some men, and when such a one comes to the bog he "vanishes like smoke" and his body is seen no more.

Four years ago two sailors attempted to cross the bog by swimming. They were seen to reach the middle of the lake, swimming strongly, and then together went down without a sound.

Major MacLaren rested for four days on the shores of the bog, living at an experimental farm maintained on the island by the Japanese department of agriculture and commerce, and then hopped off on a supposed flight to Paramushiro.

Sugar Men Organized To Help Production

HONOLULU (AP).—The first world's international conference of sugar experts was organized here recently in connection with the Pan-Pacific food conservation conference. H. P. Agce, director of the Hawaiian Sugar Planters' association, was chosen chairman. Mario Calvino, vice chairman, and George Barnette, of the Colonial Sugar Refining company, Australia, secretary.

The organization will be a permanent one and will hold a meeting in some sugar producing country every three years.

Delegates from Cuba, Porto Rico, Mexico, Australia, P. I., Philippines, Formosa, Java, Louisiana and Hawaii attended the organization meeting. They visited the plant quarantine section of the territorial board of agriculture and forestry and the cane quarantine station of the Hawaiian Sugar Planters' association.

The business of the organization will be mainly of a technical nature, dealing principally with cane breeding, eradication of cane diseases and methods of increasing production.

MAY INCREASE SALMON PACK

ANCHORAGE, Alaska (AP).—Under a plan adopted by the United States bureau of fisheries, it is hoped to increase the salmon pack of the Chuk Inlet section of Alaska from 200,000 cases in recent seasons to 500,000 within the next few years.

According to William Studdert, in charge of salmon protection, the depletion of salmon in southern Alaska has been due as much to failure to conserve the spawning grounds as to overfishing. Mr. Studdert declared the greatest enemy to the salmon were the Dolly Varden trout, which preyed on the eggs in the spawning grounds up streams and caught the salmon minnows before they could swim to safety.

"One trout," he said, "captured in a stream while the salmon fry were traveling to the ocean, revealed 70 odd fry in its intestines. To stop these inroads we
