English Still Guarding Two Germans Arrested as Spies
LONDON, (AP)—Stories of the sometimes romantic exploits of spies are recalled by the release from Dartmoor prison of Courtenay Henslow de Rysbach, who in October, 1915, was sentenced to penal servitude for life as a spy in Germany's service.
De Rysbach, a vaudeville actor and the son of a one-time Austrian subject who was naturalized in England, was arrested after the peace. He had named two spies named by him to an address in Switzerland. One was "The Bachelor of Love" and the other was "On the Way to Berlin." When they were chemically treated, an account of conditions in England written in invisible ink appeared. After imprisonment De Rysbach divulged German espionage methods.
At the Home Office it is stated that only two spies now remain in prison in this country.

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Historic Home in Louisiana To Shelter State Societies
NEW ORLEANS, (AP)—"Belle Chasse," the plantation home of Judah P. Benjamin, is to be converted into a memorial shrine and headquarters for the United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Sons of Confederate Veterans of Louisiana.
Mr. Benjamin was a United States senator from Louisiana from 1852 until he resigned from Congress at the outbreak of the Civil War and cast his fortunes with those of his home state. He became attorney general in the cabinet of Jefferson Davis and subsequently served also as secretary of war and secretary of state. He fled to England with the collapse of the Confederacy and died in Paris in 1884.
"Belle Chasse" is only a 20 minute drive from Gretna, a suburb immediately across the Mississippi river from New Orleans. The property now is held by a land company, but the newly organized Judah P. Benjamin Memorial Association has arranged to purchase the old home for \$5,500. It is estimated \$25,000 will be required to put it into the condition desired.
