Prize Winning Story Booked for Showing at Star.

Pat O'Malley who plays the juvenile lead in "The Fighting American" Universal Jewel production to be shown at the Star theater Wednesday and Thursday, claims distinction because he is one of the very few actors given leading parts who has emerged from a fight a badly defeated fighter. O'Malley is remembered for the part he had in "Pools of Blood" Universal Jewel starring Mary Phillips. As a gambler he fought against a dozen men.

"That is as it should be," he said in giving his claim to distinction. "In real life no one man can possibly win a mob."

"The Fighting American" also gives O'Malley a chance to fight, and in each case he loses, except where it is a man-to-man affair.

This picture is the prize-winning screen story in the Carl Laemmle inter-collegiate scenario scholarship contest. It was submitted by William Edward Oliver, University of California student, and selected from several thousand manuscripts.

The story is about a youth who is far more like his rough-and-ready grandfather, once a power in the trans-Pacific shipping business. The youth's father who desires that his son become a "cultured gentleman" much to the grandfather's disgust. The son is expelled from college and disowned by his father.

Stowing away on a China-bound vessel, the youth follows the girl he loves but from whom he has become estranged. In China the girl becomes prisoner of the leaders of a revolution and with the aid of a general in the Chinese army, a white man whom the youth had met in the United States and rescued from a policeman who had arrested him as a drunk tramp, rescues her after thrilling adventures that include a fight between two airplanes.

An all-star cast directed by Thomas Forman, includes, besides O'Malley, Mary Astor, Warner Oland, Edwin J. Brady, Taylor Carroll and Alfred Fisher.

Carpet Mill Uses Vast Amount of Wool Daily

The wool used daily in the weaving of carpets and rugs by a New York manufacturer is equal to the shearing from thirty thousand sheep. The soft, rich coats of these animals are turned into the looms at the rate of 120,000 pounds every day.

These and many other interesting facts were revealed recently through the publication of statistics concerning their mammoth mills at Yonkers, N. Y., by Alexander Smith & Sons Carpet Company, said to be the largest manufacturers of carpets and rugs in the world.

If all the wool used in these mills were reckoned according to the number of animals from which it is sheared, a year's output at the mills would represent the clip from 3,000,000 sheep—a number which would constitute herds beyond the imagination.

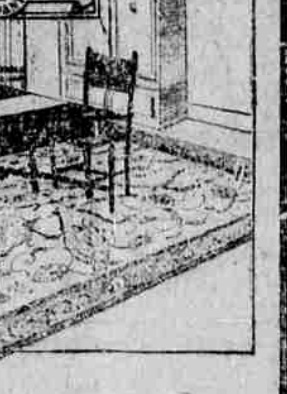
